~ENTREATIES (160)

[English, appeals, pleas, petitions, requests]

- Solomon asked for Yehowah God to listen to the entreaties of his people when they prayed to him at the temple in Jerusalem.
- And you must listen to the entreaties of your servant and of your people Israel when they pray toward this place, that you yourself may hear from the place of your dwelling, from the heavens, and you must hear and forgive. (2 Chronicles 6:21)
- Job showed how Leviathan is not going to make entreaties of mankind.
- Will it make many entreaties to you, or will it say soft words to you? (Job 41:3)
- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God to hear the voice of his entreaties when he called to him in the Holy of the temple.
- Hear the voice of my entreaties when I cry to you for help, when I raise my hands to the innermost room of your holy place.

 (Psalms 28:2)
- The Psalmist blessed Yehowah God for hearing his entreaties.
- Blessed be Yehowah, for he has heard the voice of my entreaties. (Psalms 28:6)
- The Psalmist showed that when he became panicky Yehowah heard the voice of his entreaties.
- As for me, I said when I became panicky; I shall certainly be exterminated from in front of your eyes. Surely you have heard the voice of my entreaties when I cried to you for help. (Psalms 31:22)
- Give ear, O Yehowah, to my prayer, and do pay attention to the voice of my entreaties. (Psalms 86:6)
- I do love, because Yehowah hears my voice, my entreaties. (Psalms 116:1)

- O Yehowah, do hear my voice. May your ears prove to be attentive to the voice of my entreaties. (Psalms 130:2)
- I have said to Yehowah; You are my God. Do give ear, O Yehowah, to the voice of my entreaties. (Psalms 140:6)
- The one of little means makes entreaties, but the rich answers in a strong way.
- Entreaties the one of little means speaks out, but one that is rich answers in a strong way. (Proverbs 18:23)
- Jeremiah showed that it was on a beaten path, that Israel had made many entreaties to their God, for their way had been twisted from long ago.
- On the beaten paths there has been heard a sound, the weeping, the entreaties of the sons of Israel. For they have twisted their way, they have forgotten Yehowah their God. (Jeremiah 3:21)
- Jeremiah showed that Israel would come with entreaties to their
 God, and he would listen to them and favor them.
- With weeping they will come, and with their entreaties for favor I shall bring them. I shall make them walk to torrent valleys of water, in a right way in which they will not be caused to stumble. For I have become to Israel a Father, and as for Ephraim, he is my firstborn. (Jeremiah 31:9)
- Daniel set his face toward the true God Yehowah with many entreaties, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes.
- And I proceeded to set my face to Yehowah the true God, in order to seek him with prayer and with entreaties, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. (Daniel 9:3)
- And now listen, O our God, to the prayer of your servant and to his entreaties, and cause your face to shine upon your sanctuary that is desolated, for the sake of Yehowah. (Daniel 9:17)
- Incline your ear, O my God, and hear. Do open your eyes and see our desolated conditions and the city that has been called by your name, for not according to our righteous acts are we letting

- our entreaties fall before you, but according to your many mercies. (Daniel 9:18)
- At the start of your entreaties a word went forth, and I myself have come to make report, because you are someone very desirable. So give consideration to the matter, and have understanding in the thing seen. (Daniel 9:23)
- Yehowah God showed prophetically that he would pour out upon the house of David the spirit of favor and entreaties, over the death of his own son, Jesus Christ.
- And I will pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they will certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there will be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (Zechariah 12:10)
