~ENTREATY (140)

[English, appeal, plea, petition, request]

- Pharaoh tried to take the glory away from Moses by asking him to make entreaty to Yehowah God, at his command.
- Then Moses said to Pharaoh; You take the glory over me to say when I shall make entreaty for you and your servants and your people in order to cut the frogs off from you and your houses.

 Only in the Nile River will they be left. (Exodus 8:9)
- Nonetheless Pharaoh made entreaty to stop the plagues against his land and people.
- Pharaoh now said; I, I shall send you away, and you will indeed sacrifice to Yehowah your God in the wilderness. Only do not make it quite so far away that you are going. Make entreaty in my behalf. (Exodus 8:28)
- Then Moses said; Here I am going forth from you, and I shall indeed make entreaty to Yehowah, and the gadflies will certainly turn away from Pharaoh, his servants and his people tomorrow. Only let not Pharaoh trifle again in not sending the people away to sacrifice to Yehowah. (Exodus 8:29)
- After that Moses went out from Pharaoh and made entreaty to Yehowah. (Exodus 8:30)
- So he went out from Pharaoh and made entreaty to Yehowah. (Exodus 10:18)
- The entreaty of Manasseh was granted to him, because he humbled himself before his God.
- As for his prayer and how his entreaty was granted him and all his sin and his unfaithfulness and the locations in which he built high places and set up the sacred poles and the graven images before he humbled himself, there they are written among the words of his visionaries. (2 Chronicles 33:19)
- Job showed that he would make entreaty to Yehowah God, and he would hear it, and then Job would pay his vows to his God.

- You will make entreaty to him, and he will hear you, and your vows you will pay. (Job 22:27)
- He will make entreaty to God that he may take pleasure in him, and he will see his face with joyful shouting, and He will restore His righteousness to mortal man. (Job 33:26)
- The Psalmist showed that to Yehowah God he kept calling and making entreaty for favor before him.
- To you, O Yehowah, I kept calling, and to Yehowah I kept making entreaty for favor. (Psalms 30:8)
- O Yehowah, hear my prayer, do give ear to my entreaty. In your faithfulness answer me in your righteousness. (Psalms 143:1)
- Lydia made entreaty to Paul and those with him to come into her house and stay with her, after she became a believer.
- Now when she and her household got baptized, she said with entreaty; If you men have judged me to be faithful to Yehowah, enter into my house and stay. And she just made us come. (Acts of Apostles 16:15)
- Paul showed that spirit anointed Christians are ambassadors for Christ, making entreaty to all men, to become reconciled to God.
- We are therefore ambassadors substituting for Christ, as though God were making entreaty through us. As substitutes for Christ we beg; Become reconciled to God. (2 Corinthians 5:20)
- The Thessalonians begged Paul with much entreaty for the privilege of kindly contributing to the ministry destined for the holy ones in Jerusalem, that Paul was himself organizing.
- While they of their own accord kept begging us with much entreaty for the privilege of kindly giving and for a share in the ministry destined for the holy ones. (2 Corinthians 8:4)
