## ~ENTRUSTED (67)

[English, handed over, trusted, commended, delegated, assigned]

- Yehowah entrusted Moses with all of his house.
- Not so my servant Moses! He is being entrusted with all my house. (Numbers 12:7)
- The roll of Jerusalem's writings they entrusted to the dining room of Elishama.
- Then they came in to the king, to the courtyard, and the roll they entrusted to the dining room of Elishama the secretary, and they began to tell all the words in the ears of the king. (Jeremiah 36:20)
- Paul and Barnabus sailed off for the work with which they were entrusted.
- And from there they sailed off for Antioch, where they had been entrusted to the undeserved kindness of God for the work they had fully performed. (Acts of Apostles 14:26)
- The brothers entrusted Paul and Silas with God's undeserved kindness in their work.
- Paul selected Silas and went off after he had been entrusted by the brothers to the undeserved kindness of Yehowah. (Acts of Apostles 15:40)
- The Jews as a nation were entrusted with the sacred pronouncements of God.
- A great deal in every way. First of all, because they were entrusted with the sacred pronouncements of God. (Romans 3:2)
- Paul showed that he had been entrusted with a stewardship by God, which he wanted to perform willingly
- If I perform this willingly, I have a reward, but if I do it against my will, all the same I have a stewardship entrusted to me. (1 Corinthians 9:17)

- Paul had entrusted to himself the Good News for those who are uncircumcised.
- But, on the contrary, when they saw that I had entrusted to me the Good News for those who are uncircumcised, just as Peter had it for those who are circumcised. (Galatians 2:7)
- As a messenger entrusted with this Good News, Paul spoke so as to please not men but God who makes proof of all hearts.
- But, just as we have been proved by God as fit to be entrusted with the Good News, so we speak, as pleasing, not men, but God, who makes proof of our hearts. (1 Thessalonians 2:4)
- According to the glorious Good News of the happy God, with which I was entrusted. (1 Timothy 1:11)
- Whereas in his own due times he made his word manifest in the preaching with which I was entrusted, under command of our Savior, God. (Titus 1:3)
