~EPAENETUS (25) (E-pae'ne-tus) [Praised, Commended]

- A Christian in the congregation at Rome whom Paul mentions by name and to whom he sends personal greetings.
- And greet the congregation that is in their house. Greet my beloved Epaenetus, who is a firstfruits of Asia for Christ. (Romans 16:5)
- Epaenetus is called a firstfruits of Asia. Possibly he was contacted personally by Paul, since the household of Stephanus is similarly referred to as the firstfruits of Achaia, and Paul baptized this household.
- Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas. As for the rest, I do not know whether I baptized anybody else. (1 Corinthians 1:16)
- Now I exhort you, brothers. You know that the household of Stephanas is the firstfruits of Achaia and that they set themselves to minister to the holy ones. (1 Corinthians 16:15)
