[English, regard, respect, admiration, high regard, good opinion]

- Naaman was held in <u>esteem</u> as a great man before his lord because by means of him Yehowah had given salvation to Syria.
- Now a certain Naaman, the chief of the army of the king of Syria, had become a great man before his lord and held in esteem, because it was by him that Yehowah had given salvation to Syria, and the man himself had proved to be a valiant, mighty man, though a leper. (2 Kings 5:1)
- Wisdom is something men should highly esteem and it will exalt one if they do.
- Highly esteem it, and it will exalt you. It will glorify you because you embrace it. (Proverbs 4:8)
