[English, alienated, separated, not speaking, at odds, divided, on bad terms]

- Yehowah told the spies that they would in the course of forty years get to know what his being estranged meant, for they had disloyally left him by not exercising faith in his ability to bring them into the Promised Land.
- By the number of the days that you spied out the land, forty days, a day for a year, a day for a year, you will answer for your errors forty years, as you must know what my being estranged means. (Numbers 14:34)
- The Psalmist prophesies about the Messiah who becomes one estranged to his brothers.
- I have become one estranged to my brothers, and a foreigner to the sons of my mother. (Psalms 69:8)
