- Yehowah told the spies that they would in the course of forty years get to know what his being **estranged** meant, for they had disloyally left him by not exercising faith in his ability to bring them into the Promised Land.
- By the number of the days that you spied out the land, forty days, a day for a year, a day for a year, you will answer for your errors forty years, as you must know what my being **estranged** means. (**Numbers 14:34**)

- I have become one **estranged** to my brothers, and a foreigner to the sons of my mother. (**Psalms 69:8**)
