[English, everlasting, undying, unending, never ending, perpetual, endless, ceaseless, timeless, interminable, Opposite of, temporary]

- Joseph's blessing is shown to be superior to the blessing of the eternal mountains.
- The blessings of your father will indeed be superior to the blessings of the eternal mountains, to the ornament of the indefinitely lasting hills. They will continue upon the head of Joseph, even upon the crown of the head of the one singled out from his brothers. (Genesis 49:26)
- Yehowah promises a deliver who will become to Israel an eternal father.
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us, and the princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder.

  And his name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,

  Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
- Habakkuk speaks of Yehowah's day when the eternal mountains get to be smashed.
- He stood still, that he might shake up the earth. He saw, and then caused nations to leap. And the eternal mountains got to be smashed, the indefinitely lasting hills bowed down. The walkings of long ago are his. (Habakkuk 3:6)
- Paul writes about how God's fine qualities are perceived by the things he has made, even his eternal power and godship.
- For his invisible qualities are clearly seen from the world's creation onward, because they are perceived by the things made, even his eternal power and godship, so that they are inexcusable. (Romans 1:20)
- Writing to the Ephesians Paul told them of God's eternal purpose that he formed in connection with his firstborn son Jesus Christ.
- According to the eternal purpose that he formed in connection with the Christ, Jesus our Lord. (Ephesians 3:11)

- Yehowah has kept the angels that sinned against him before the flood chained within eternal bonds of dense darkness, regarding his advancing purpose, until the judgment of the great day.
- And the angels that did not keep their original position but forsook their own proper dwelling place he has reserved with eternal bonds under dense darkness for the judgment of the great day. (Jude 1:6)
