~ETHAN 1 (29) (E'than) [Enduring, Everflowing]

- One of four men whose wisdom, though great, was exceeded by Solomon's.
- And he was wiser than any other man, than Ethan the Ezrahite and Heman and Calcol and Darda the sons of Mahol, and his fame came to be in all the nations all around. (1 Kings 4:31)
- This Ethan may be the writer of (Psalms Chapter 89), for the superscription identifies Ethan the Ezrahite as its writer.
- And the sons of Zerah were Zimri and Ethan and Heman and Calcol and Dara. There were five of them in all. (1 Chronicles 2:6)
- Ethan, Heman, Calcol, and Dara are all spoken of as sons of Zerah of the tribe of Judah and possibly are the same as the men mentioned in First Kings. Ethan is referred to as the father of Azariah.
- And the sons of **Ethan** were Azariah. (1 Chronicles 2:8)
