(Eu-o'di-a) [Good Way, Prospering]

- **A woman in the Christian congregation at Philippi who had fought side by side with the apostle Paul and others in the Good News. **Euodia** was apparently having some difficulty in resolving a problem that had arisen between her and Syntyche, and Paul admonished these two Christian women to be of the same mind in the Lord.**
- ****Euodia** I exhort and Syntyche I exhort to be of the same mind in the Lord. (**Philippians 4:2**)**
- **Yes, I request you too, genuine yokefellow, keep assisting these women who have striven side by side with me in the Good News along with Clement as well as the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life. (**Philippians 4:3**)**
