## ~EXCESS (80)

[English, surplus, glut, overload, surfeit, overkill, Opposite of, shortage]

- Those in excess of the sons of the Levites were to be compensated for by a ransom price.
- And as the ransom price of the two hundred and seventy-three from the firstborn of the sons of Israel, who are in excess of the Levites. (Numbers 3:46)
- And you must give the money to Aaron and his sons as the ransom price of those who are in excess of them. (Numbers 3:48)
- So Moses took the money of the redemption price from those who were in excess of the ransom price of the Levites. (Numbers 3:49)
- Jeremiah showed that the virgin Israel had done a terrible thing to excess, and she was known among the nations for this sin.
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Ask for yourselves, please, among the nations. Who has heard things like these? There is a horrible thing that the virgin of Israel has done to an excess. (Jeremiah 18:13)
- Nebuchadnezzar heated the fiery furnace to excess before throwing the three Hebrew men into it.
- Just because the kings word was harsh and the furnace was heated to excess, these able-bodied men that took up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were the ones that the fiery flame killed. (Daniel 3:22)
- Jesus showed that oaths, by this or that, in excess of just doing, what we said we would do, are from the wicked one.
- Just let your word Yes mean Yes, your No, No. What is in excess of these is from the wicked one. (Matthew 5:37)

- Paul showed, that by Yehowah God's undeserved-kindness he labored in excess of all the other apostles in Christian service to Yehowah God and his Christ.
- But by God's undeserved kindness I am what I am. And his undeserved kindness that was toward me did not prove to be in vain, but I labored in excess of them all, yet not I but the undeserved kindness of God that is with me. (1 Corinthians 15:10)
- Paul also showed that in his Christian ministry that he had come to be in blows to an excess.
- Are they ministers of Christ? I reply like a madman, I am more outstandingly one, in labors more plentifully, in prisons more plentifully, in blows to an excess, in near-deaths often. (2 Corinthians 11:23)
- Paul was shown an excess of revelations of Yehowah God's will through the spirit, but was also given a thorn in the flesh so that he might not feel too exalted.
- Just because of the excess of the revelations. Therefore, that I might not feel overly exalted, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, an angel of Satan, to keep slapping me, that I might not be overly exalted. (2 Corinthians 12:7)
- Paul while a Jew persecuted the Christian congregation to an excess, and devastated it.
- You, of course, heard about my conduct formerly in Judaism, that to the point of excess I kept on persecuting the congregation of God and devastating it. (Galatians 1:13)
