

## ~EXCITEMENT (50)

[English, enthusiasm, thrill, exhilaration, anticipation, stimulation, pleasure, Opposite of, boredom]

- Zophar the Naamathite got **excited** inwardly by what Job said in rebuttal to his three companions.
- Therefore do my own disquieting thoughts themselves answer me, even on account of my inward **excitement**. (Job 20:2)
- Yehowah spoke to Job about the horse which when charging with pounding **excitement** swallows up the earth in its charge.
- With pounding and **excitement** it swallows up the earth, and it does not believe that it is the sound of a horn. (Job 39:24)
- Yehowah would cause to fall upon his disobedient people sudden **excitement** and disturbances.
- To me their widows have become more numerous than the sand grains of the seas. I will bring for them, upon mother, young man, the despoiler at midday. I will cause to fall upon them suddenly **excitement** and disturbances. (Jeremiah 15:8)
- Yehowah's well thought out purpose is not like that of a man, who acts with **excitement**.
- I shall not express my burning anger. I shall not bring Ephraim to ruin again, for I am God and not man, the Holy One in the midst of you, and I shall not come in **excitement**. (Hosea 11:9)
- Yehowah's day is spoken of by Joel as bringing to the inhabitants a glow of **excitement** to their faces.
- Because of it, peoples will be in severe pains. As for all faces, they will certainly collect a glow of **excitement**. (Joel 2:6)
- Nahum describes the destruction of Nineveh as producing a glow of **excitement** on all faces.
- Emptiness and voidness, and a city laid waste! And the heart is melting, and there is a tottering of the knees, and severe pains

are in all hips, and as for the faces of all of them, they have collected a glow of excitement. (Nahum 2:10)
