[English, movements, aerobics, workout, training, drills]

- He that **exercises** faith in Jesus Christ will not be judged.
- He that **exercises** faith in him is not to be judged. He that does not exercise faith has been judged already, because he has not exercised faith in the name of the only-begotten Son of God. (John 3:18)
- He that **exercises** faith in the Son of God, has everlasting life.
- He that **exercises** faith in the Son has everlasting life. He that disobeys the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)
- He that **exercises** faith in Jesus Christ will never get thirsty for spiritual waters of truth or spiritual food, at all.
- Jesus said to them; I am the bread of life. He that comes to me will not get hungry at all, and he that **exercises** faith in me will never get thirsty at all. (John 6:35)

- Jesus showed, that he that **exercises** faith in Jesus would do even greater works than Jesus did.
- Most truly I say to you, he that **exercises** faith in me, that one also will do the works that I do, and he will do works greater than these, because I am going my way to the Father. (**John 14:12**)
- With the heart ones **exercises** faith for righteousness, but salvation come to those who **exercise** their faith through words of faith.
- For with the heart one **exercises** faith for righteousness, but with the mouth one makes public declaration for salvation. (**Romans 10:10**)
- Every man taking part in an athletic contest **exercises** self-control in all things, so as to win.
- Moreover, every man taking part in a contest **exercises** self-control in all things. Now they, of course, do it that they may get a corruptible crown, but we an incorruptible one. (**1 Corinthians 9:25**)
- Perfect love throws fear outside, because fear **exercises** a restraint, and love knows no bounds.
- There is no fear in love, but perfect love throws fear outside, because fear **exercises** a restraint. Indeed, he that is under fear has not been made perfect in love. (**1 John 4:18**)
