[English, movements, aerobics, workout, training, drills]

- He that exercises faith in Jesus Christ will not be judged.
- He that exercises faith in him is not to be judged. He that does not exercise faith has been judged already, because he has not exercised faith in the name of the only-begotten Son of God. (John 3:18)
- He that exercises faith in the Son of God, has everlasting life.
- He that exercises faith in the Son has everlasting life. He that disobeys the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)
- He that exercises faith in Jesus Christ will never get thirsty for spiritual waters of truth or spiritual food, at all.
- Jesus said to them; I am the bread of life. He that comes to me will not get hungry at all, and he that exercises faith in me will never get thirsty at all. (John 6:35)
- Yehowah God's will is for everyone exercising faith in his son to gain everlasting life.
- For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son and exercises faith in him should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

- For with the heart one exercises faith for righteousness, but with the mouth one makes public declaration for salvation. (Romans 10:10)
