- Paul used the power that God supplied those his spirit **exerting** himself in doing his will.
- To this end I am indeed working hard, **exerting** myself in accordance with the operation of him and which is at work in me with power. (**Colossians 1:29**)
- Epaphras **exerted** himself in his prayers in behalf of the Colossian Christians.
- Epaphras, who is from among you, a slave of Christ Jesus, sends you his greetings, always **exerting** himself in your behalf in his prayers, that you may finally stand complete and with firm conviction in all the will of God. (**Colossians 4:12**)
