- When Dorcas died many came and **exhibited** to Peter all of the garments and fine works she had done in behalf of others.
- At that Peter rose and went with them. And when he arrived, they led him up into the upper chamber, and all the widows presented themselves to him weeping and **exhibiting** many inner garments and outer garments that Dorcas used to make while she was with them. (**Acts of Apostles 9:39**)
- Christians are counseled to not commit theft but to **exhibit** good fidelity to the full so as to adorn the teaching of Christ.
- Not committing theft, but **exhibiting** good fidelity to the full, so that they may adorn the teaching of our Savior, God, in all things. (**Titus 2:10**)
- Paul's counseled Titus to be **exhibiting** mildness toward all men.
- To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be reasonable, **exhibiting** all mildness toward all men. (**Titus 3:2**)
