[English, urging, pressing, pushing, encouraging, insisting, pressuring]

- Peter kept exhorting them saying, get saved from this wicked generation.
- And with many other words he bore thorough witness and kept exhorting them, saying; Get saved from this crooked generation. (Acts of Apostles 2:40)
- The brothers wrote the brothers in Achaia exhorting them to receive them kindly.
- Further, because he was desiring to go across into Achaia, the brothers wrote the disciples, exhorting them to receive him kindly. So when he got there, he greatly helped those who had believed on account of God's undeserved kindness. (Acts of Apostles 18:27)
- Paul exhorted his fellow Christians as a father exhorts his children.
- In harmony with that you well know how, as a father does his children, we kept exhorting each one of you, and consoling and bearing witness to you. (1 Thessalonians 2:11)
- Likewise keep on exhorting the younger men to be sound in mind. (Titus 2:6)
- Keep on speaking these things and exhorting and reproving with full authority to command. Let no man ever despise you. (Titus 2:15)
- I am exhorting you rather on the basis of love, seeing that I am such as I am, Paul an aged man, yes, now also a prisoner for the sake of Christ Jesus. (Philemon 1:9)
- I am exhorting you concerning my child, to whom I became a father while in my prison bonds, Onesimus. (Philemon 1:10)
- But keep on exhorting one another each day, as long as it may be called Today, for fear any one of you should become hardened by

the deceptive power of sin. (Hebrews 3:13)
