- In Joseph's day a severe famine existed in the whole land of Canaan.
- So Israel's sons came along with the others who were coming to buy, because the famine existed in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 42:5)
- Job showed that if he existed in their position he would not treat them as they were treating him.
- I myself also could well speak as you men do. If only your souls existed where my soul is, would I be brilliant in words against you, and would I wag my head against you? (Job 16:4)
- John the Baptist bore witness that Jesus had existed before him in heaven.
