- Jacob blessed Joseph and confessed that the true God Yehowah had been shepherding him throughout his entire existence.
- And he proceeded to bless Joseph and to say; The true God before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked; The true God who has been shepherding me during all my existence until this day. (Genesis 48:15)
- Yehowah kept the wicked Pharaoh in existence only for the purpose of showing him his power and of declaring his name in all the earth.
- But, in fact, for this cause I have kept you in existence, for the sake of showing you my power and in order to have my name declared in all the earth. (Exodus 9:16)
- Yehowah let the wicked city of Jerusalem stay in existence beyond its time of accounting because of his promises to David.
- For, on account of David, Yehowah his God gave him a lamp in Jerusalem by raising his son up after him and keeping Jerusalem in existence. (1 Kings 15:4)
- The congregator showed that there is nothing new in existence.
- Does anything exist of which one may say; See this! It is new? It has already had existence for time indefinite, what has come into existence is from time prior to us. (Ecclesiastes 1:10)
- The Sabbath, Jesus said; Came into existence for the sake of man and not the other way around.
- So he went on to say to them; The Sabbath came into existence for the sake of man, and not man for the sake of the Sabbath.

 (Mark 2:27)
- All things material and spirit came into existence through Jesus Christ in his heavenly present-human existence.

- All things came into existence through him, and apart from him not even one thing came into existence. What has come into existence (John 1:3)
- He was in the world, and the world came into existence through him, but the world did not know him. (John 1:10)
- Jesus admitted to his opposers that he had been in existence before Abraham lived.
- Jesus said to them; Most truly I say to you, before Abraham came into existence, I have been. (John 8:58)
- Paul shows that if anyone is in union with Christ he is a new creation, something new in existence.
- Consequently if anyone is in union with Christ, he is a new creation, the old things passed away, look! New things have come into existence. (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- James showed how wrong it is to worship God whom we cannot see and to curse men, whom we can see, who have come into existence in the likeness of God.
- With it we bless Yehowah, even the Father, and yet with it we curse men who have come into existence in the likeness of God. (James 3:9)
