- Yehowah God promised Noah to wipe every **existing** thing off the surface of the ground, in just seven more days.
- For in just seven days more I am making it rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights, and I will wipe every **existing** thing that I have made off the surface of the ground. ([Genesis 7:4](#))
- Thus he wiped out every **existing** thing that was on the surface of the ground, from man to beast, to moving animal and to flying creature of the heavens, and they were wiped off the earth, and only Noah and those who were with him in the ark kept on surviving. ([Genesis 7:23](#))
- Yehowah God warned Pharaoh through Moses, that the locusts he would bring would be worse than any existing from the time of their forefathers.
- And your houses and the houses of all your servants and the houses of all Egypt will be filled to an extent that your fathers and your father's fathers have not seen it from the day of their **existing** upon the ground until this day. With that he turned and went out from Pharaoh. ([Exodus 10:6](#))
- The earth opened under Dathan and Abiram swallowing up them, and every **existing** thing that they possessed.
- Nor what he did to Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab the son of Reuben, when the earth opened its mouth and proceeded to swallow them up and their households and their tents and every **existing** thing that stepped after them in the midst of all Israel. ([Deuteronomy 11:6](#))
- Job compared men to a blossom that comes forth and is cut off, and like a shadow that does not keep **existing**.
- Like a blossom he has come forth and is cut off, and he runs away like the shadow and does not keep **existing**. ([Job 14:2](#))

- Jesus asked faithless Jews what they had gone out to the wilderness to see in John the Baptist, for men **existing** in luxury live in splendid houses.
- What, then, did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft outer garments? Why, those in splendid dress and **existing** in luxury are in royal houses. (**Luke 7:25**)
- In Jesus' parable of the rich man and Lazarus, the rich man after death was **existing** in torments, contrary to the way of his earlier life.
- And in Hades he lifted up his eyes, he **existing** in torments, and he saw Abraham afar off and Lazarus in the bosom position with him. (**Luke 16:23**)
- The High Priest was a member of the then **existing** sect of the Sadducees.
- But the High Priest and all those with him, the then **existing** sect of the Sadducees, rose and became filled with jealousy. (**Acts of Apostles 5:17**)
- The city recorder charged an angry mob that no reason **existed** for their disorderly assembly.
- For we are really in danger of being charged with sedition over today's affair, no single cause **existing** that will permit us to render a reason for this disorderly mob. (**Acts of Apostles 19:40**)
- Paul showed that the **existing** governments of men stand placed in their relative positions by Yehowah God.
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the **existing** authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (**Romans 13:1**)
- Jesus, although he was **existing** in heaven in God's form as a spirit, gave no consideration to seizing God's position.
- Who, although he was **existing** in God's form, gave no consideration to a seizure, namely, that he should be equal to God. (**Philippians 2:6**)
