~EXPECTATION (165)

[English, hope, anticipation, belief, prospect, probability]

- Job showed that Leviathan would disappoint ones expectation about it, that they could deal with it successfully.
- Look! ones expectation about it will certainly be disappointed.
 One will also be hurled down at the mere sight of it. (Job 41:9)
- The Psalmist showed, that his very soul had been in expectation of Yehowah God, his helper and his shield.
- Our very soul has been in expectation of Yehowah. Our helper and our shield he is. (Psalms 33:20)
- The Psalmist showed that his expectation or hope was in Yehowah God.
- And now for what have I hoped, O Yehowah? My expectation is toward you. (Psalms 39:7)
- The expectation of the righteous ones is a rejoicing, but the hope of the wicked ones will perish.
- The expectation of the righteous ones is a rejoicing, but the very hope of the wicked ones will perish. (Proverbs 10:28)
- When a man dies, any expectation based upon his past powerfulness also perishes.
- When a wicked man dies, his hope perishes, and even expectation based on powerfulness has perished. (Proverbs 11:7)
- When expectation is postponed, it makes mankind's heart sick, but the thing hoped for is a tree of life when it arrives.
- Expectation postponed is making the heart sick, but the thing desired is a tree of life when it does come. (Proverbs 13:12)
- Isaiah showed, that he would keep in expectation of Yehowah God, who was concealing his face from the house of Jacob.

- And I will keep in expectation of Yehowah, who is concealing his face from the house of Jacob, and I will hope in him. (Isaiah 8:17)
- Isaiah showed that Yehowah God would keep in expectation of showing his people favor and mercy, following their judgment, for he is an optimistic and loving God, who disciplines his people for a purpose.
- And therefore Yehowah will keep in expectation of showing you favor, and therefore he will rise up to show you mercy. For Yehowah is a God of judgment. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (Isaiah 30:18)
- Yehowah is a God acting in favor of the one in expectation of him.
- And from time long ago none have heard, nor have any given ear, nor has an eye itself seen a God, except you, that acts for the one that keeps in expectation of him. (Isaiah 64:4)
- Jeremiah lamented that his excellency had perished and his expectation from Yehowah God, for what he had hoped for, the relief of his people, could not now come forth, after Jerusalem fell to the Babylonians.
- And I keep saying; My excellency has perished, and my expectation from Yehowah. (Lamentations 3:18)
- Daniel showed through a vision, that happy is the one keeping in expectation, who arrives at the one thousand three hundred and thirty five days.
- Happy is the one who is keeping in expectation and who arrives at the one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days! (Daniel 12:12)
- Habakkuk showed, that the vision he saw was for the appointed time of the end, and that even if it should seem to delay, it would come true and it would not be late, so then men should keep in expectation of it always.
- For the vision is yet for the appointed time, and it keeps panting on to the end, and it will not tell a lie. Even if it should delay,

keep in expectation of it, for it will without fail come true. It will not be late. (Habakkuk 2:3)

- Yehowah tells all men to keep in expectation of his rising up for judgment of all the earth, when he will collect nations and kingdoms together of judgment.
- Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth will be devoured. (Zephaniah 3:8)
- When Jesus came to be baptized by John the Baptist the people of Israel were all in expectation of the coming forth of the of God's Messiah.
- Now as the people were in expectation and all were reasoning in their hearts about John; May he perhaps be the Christ? (Luke 3:15)
- Jesus foretold, that during his presence men, would become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth.
- While men become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Luke 21:26)
- Paul showed that the eager expectation of all the creation must wait for the revealing of the sons of God, the 144,000, Yehowah God himself selected to rule the earth in righteousness.
- For the eager expectation of the creation is waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. (Romans 8:19)
- Paul's eager expectation and hope was that Christ might be magnified by the activities of Paul and others, whether through life or through death.
- In harmony with my eager expectation and hope that I shall not be ashamed in any respect, but that in all freeness of speech Christ will, as always before, so now be magnified by means of

my body, whether through life or through death. (Philippians 1:20)

- Paul showed that for spirit anointed Christians who fall away from their faith, that there is a certain expectation of judgment and a fiery jealousy that is going to consume them.
- But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy that is going to consume those in opposition. (Hebrews 10:27)
- Paul showed that faith is the assured expectation of all the things men have hope in God to obtain, and it is the evident demonstrate of real things they themselves have not yet seen.
- Faith is the assured expectation of things hoped for, the evident demonstration of realities though not beheld. (Hebrews 11:1)
