

~EXPECTING (52)

[English, pregnant, having a baby, in the family way, expectant]

- The crowd received Jesus kindly for they were all **expecting** him.
- When Jesus got back, the crowd received him kindly, for they were all **expecting** him. (Luke 8:40)
- Jesus warned his slaves against unfaithfulness for he said he would come when they were not **expecting** him and deal severely with hypocrites.
- The master of that slave will come on a day that he is not **expecting** him and in an hour that he does not know, and he will punish him with the greatest severity and assign him a part with the unfaithful ones. (Luke 12:46)
- A certain man lame from his mother's womb fixed his attention upon Peter and John **expecting** to get something from them.
- So he fixed his attention upon them, **expecting** to get something from them. (Acts of Apostles 3:5)
- Cornelius was **expecting** the arrival of Peter for he had sent men to invite him into his home to speak the truth to him and all his household.
- On the day after that he entered into Caesarea. Cornelius, of course, was **expecting** them and had called together his relatives and intimate friends. (Acts of Apostles 10:24)
- Peter confessed that he had been delivered by God out of the hand of the Jews and all that they were **expecting** to do to him.
- And Peter, coming to himself, said; Now I actually know that Yehowah sent his angel forth and delivered me out of Herod's hand and from all that the people of the Jews were **expecting**. (Acts of Apostles 12:11)
- When Paul was shipwrecked he was near a campfire and a snake came out and bit him and all watching were **expecting** that he would swell up and die for the snake was a poisonous one.

- But they were **expecting** he was going to swell up with inflammation or suddenly drop dead. After they waited for a long while and beheld nothing hurtful happen to him, they changed their mind and began saying he was a god. (**Acts of Apostles 28:6**)
