## ~EXPERIENCED (102)

[English, knowledgeable, skilled, practiced, qualified, veteran, Opposite of, inexperienced]

- Yehowah God told Moses to select experienced capable men of every tribe to act as heads over their people.
- Get wise and discreet and experienced men of your tribes, that I may set them as heads over you. (Deuteronomy 1:13)
- So I took the heads of your tribes, men wise and experienced, and put them as heads over you, chiefs of thousands and chiefs of hundreds and chiefs of fifties and chiefs of tens and officers of your tribes. (Deuteronomy 1:15)
- Yehowah God let some nations remain to test out Israel, those that had not experienced war when Canaan was taken by the Jews.
- Now these are the nations that Yehowah let stay so as by them to test Israel, that is, all those who had not experienced any of the wars of Canaan. (Judges 3:1)
- It was only in order for the generations of the sons of Israel to have the experience, so as to teach them war, that is, only those who before that had not experienced such things. (Judges 3:2)
- When capturing a city, only women who had not yet had sexual intercourse were preserved alive, and anyone who had experienced it was devoted to destruction.
- And this is the thing that you should do; Every male and every woman that has experienced lying with a male you should devote to destruction. (Judges 21:11)
- Solomon told Hiram that his people were experienced at cutting down trees.
- And send me timbers of cedar, juniper and algum from Lebanon, for I myself well know that your servants are experienced at cutting down the trees of Lebanon, and here my servants are together with your servants. (2 Chronicles 2:8)

- Hiram told Solomon that he was a man experienced and wise in discretion and understanding.
- And Hiram went on to say; Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, who made the heavens and the earth, because he has given to David the king a wise son, experienced in discretion and understanding, who will build a house to Yehowah and a house for his kingship. (2 Chronicles 2:12)
- Hiram sent a skilled and experienced man to assist in the temple building, whose mother was a Jew and whose father was Tyrian.
- And now I do send a skillful man, experienced in understanding, belonging to Hiram-abi. (2 Chronicles 2:13)
- The son of a woman of the sons of Dan, but whose father was a man of Tyre, experienced, to work in gold and in silver, in copper, in iron, in stones and in timbers, in wool dyed reddish purple, in blue thread and in fine fabric and in crimson and at cutting every sort of engraving and at designing every sort of device that may be given to him along with your own skillful men and the skillful men of my lord David your father. (2 Chronicles 2:14)
- Amos showed a time of mourning so profound, that people would call a farmer to mourning, and to wailing those experienced in lamentation.
- Therefore this is what Yehowah the God of armies, Yehowah, has said; In all the public squares there will be wailing, and in all the streets people will be saying; Ah! Ah! And they will have to call a farmer to mourning, and to wailing those experienced in lamentation. (Amos 5:16)
- Paul told the Corinthians that three times he experienced shipwreck while in his ministry to the nations.
- Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I experienced shipwreck, a night and a day I have spent in the deep. (2 Corinthians 11:25)
- Paul told Timothy that some spirit anointed Christians had experienced shipwreck concerning their faith.
- Holding faith and a good conscience, which some have thrust

aside and have experienced shipwreck concerning their faith. (1 Timothy 1:19)
