~EXPERIENCE (84)

[English, knowledge, skill, practice, understanding, familiarity, know how]

- Jacob, while tending Laban's sheepfold experienced extremes of heat and cold and loss of sleep.
- It has been my experience that by day the heat consumed me and the cold by night, and my sleep would flee from my eyes. (Genesis 31:40)
- Some of the nations of Canaan were allowed to remain for a time give experience to the succeeding generations how to carry out war.
- It was only in order for the generations of the sons of Israel to have the experience, so as to teach them war, that is, only those who before that had not experienced such things. (Judges 3:2)
- Gideon then put the older men of the city through an experience using thorns and briers.
- Then he took the older men of the city and thorns of the wilderness and briers, and with them he put the men of Succoth through an experience. (Judges 8:16)
- Wicked Agag thought his being brought before Samuel would result in escape from the bitter experience of death, but Samuel in accord with Yehowah's instruction hacked him to pieces as Agag had done to many others.
- After that Samuel said; Bring Agag the king of Amalek near to me. Then Agag went to him reluctantly, and Agag began to say to himself; Truly the bitter experience of death has departed. (1 Samuel 15:32)
- Once Babylon fell she would never regain her prominence and experience being called delicate and dainty, a Mistress of Kingdoms.
- Come down and sit down in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon. Sit down on the earth where there is no throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans. For you will not experience again that people call you delicate and dainty. (Isaiah 47:1)

- Sit down silently and come into the darkness, O daughter of the Chaldeans, for you will not experience again that people call you Mistress of Kingdoms. (Isaiah 47:5)
- Yehowah showed that in time Jerusalem's people would experience exquisite delight and consolation from the teat of her glory.
- For the reason that you will suck and certainly get satisfaction from the breast of full consolation by her, for the reason that you will sip and experience exquisite delight from the teat of her glory. (Isaiah 66:11)
- The looked for hope of the cities of Gaza and Ekron would experience shame.
- Ashkelon will see and get afraid, and as for Gaza, she will also feel very severe pains, Ekron also, because her looked-for hope will have to experience shame. And a king will certainly perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon herself will not be inhabited. (Zechariah 9:5)
- Because Yehowah was against them they and the riders of their horses would experience shame in battle.
- And they must become like mighty men stamping down in the mire of the streets in the battle. And they must get engaged in battle, for Yehowah is with them, and the riders of horses will have to experience shame. (Zechariah 10:5)
- Many Christians were exposed to tribulations before others and some also became sharers with those who experienced these things.
- Sometimes while you were being exposed as in a theater both to reproaches and tribulations, and sometimes while you became sharers with those who were having such an experience. (Hebrews 10:33)
