- Chenaniah was an **expert** in carrying and in giving instruction in carrying
- And Chenaniah the chief of the Levites in carrying, he giving instruction in carrying, for he was **expert**. (1 Chronicles 15:22)
- In fairness they cast lots so that the **expert** did not fare any better than the learner.
- So they cast lots as to the things to be taken care of, the little being just the same as the great, the **expert** along with the learner. (1 Chronicles 25:8)
- And the men were acting in faithfulness in the work, and over them there were appointed Jahath and Obadiah the Levites, from the sons of Merari, and Zechariah and Meshullam, from the sons of the Kohathites, to act as overseers. And the Levites, each of whom was **expert** with the instruments of song. (2 Chronicles 34:12)
- Yehowah promised through Isaiah to remove food from all his people including the **expert** in magical arts.
- Chief of fifty and highly respected man and counselor and **expert** in magical arts, and the skilled charmer. (Isaiah 3:3)
