- Joseph deceived his brothers, by saying that they had come to see the exposed condition of Egypt then under the famine conditions.
- Immediately Joseph remembered the dreams that he had dreamed respecting them, and he went on to say to them; You are spies! You have come to see the exposed condition of the land! (Genesis 42:9)
- But he said to them; Not so! Because you have come to see the exposed condition of the land! (Genesis 42:12)
- The priests were to wear certain garb, so that their private parts would not be exposed when they ascended Yehowah God's altar.
- And you must not go up by steps to my altar, that your private parts may not be exposed upon it. (Exodus 20:26)
- A man lying down with a menstruating woman had exposed her source of life to infection, endangering her very life.
- And where a man lies down with a menstruating woman and does lay bare her nakedness, he has exposed her source, and she herself has laid bare the source of her blood. So both of them must be cut off from among their people. (Leviticus 20:18)
- A man was not to have sexual relations with sisters of his father or mother, because it would be a blood relation that he had exposed.
- And the nakedness of your mother's sister and of your father's sister you must not lay bare, because it is his blood relation that one has exposed. They should answer for their error. (Leviticus 20:19)
- Gideon exposed a fleece of wool on the threshing floor for a sign from Yehowah God of his favor.
- Here I am keeping a fleece of wool exposed on the threshing floor. If dew comes to be on the fleece alone but on all the earth

there is dryness, then I must know that you will save Israel by means of me, just as you have promised. (Judges 6:37)

- The two Hebrews exposed themselves to the Philistine guards making them think that they were surrendering.
- With that the two of them exposed themselves to the outpost of the Philistines. And the Philistines proceeded to say; Here are the Hebrews coming out from the holes where they have hidden themselves. (1 Samuel 14:11)
- When Saul and Jonathan were exposed to reproach by the Philistines, David gathered together their bones and had them buried.
- And he proceeded to bring up from there the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son, furthermore, they gathered the bones of the men being exposed. (2 Samuel 21:13)
- Through Ezekiel Yehowah God showed that he would bring down their wall of lies and untruth and expose the foundation of it to everyone.
- And I will tear down the wall that you men have plastered with whitewash and bring it into contact with the earth, and its foundation must be exposed. And she will certainly fall, and you must come to an end in the midst of her, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:14)
- Ezekiel showed that Judah's wickedness would be exposed just like that of Israel who had gone before them to exile.
- Before your own badness got to be exposed, just as at the time of the reproach of the daughters of Syria and of all round about her, the daughters of the Philistines, those treating you with scorn on all sides. (Ezekiel 16:57)
- There is nothing hidden except for the purpose of being exposed.
- For there is nothing hidden except for the purpose of being exposed, nothing has become carefully concealed but for the purpose of coming into the open. (Mark 4:22)
- When Moses was exposed to the daughter of Pharaoh, she brought him up as her own son.

- But when he was exposed, the daughter of Pharaoh picked him up and brought him up as her own son. (Acts of Apostles 7:21)
- Everything within creation is naked and openly exposed to the eyes of Yehowah God, with whom men have an accounting.
- And there is not a creation that is not manifest to his sight, but all things are naked and openly exposed to the eyes of him with whom we have an accounting. (Hebrews 4:13)
- Some spirit anointed Christians were exposed to reproaches and tribulations, as if they were in a theater, and sometimes they shared with those undergoing such wicked treatment.
- Sometimes while you were being exposed as in a theater both to reproaches and tribulations, and sometimes while you became sharers with those who were having such an experience. (Hebrews 10:33)
