

## ~EXPOSE (50)

- Yehowah told Moses to **expose** all of the older men to the sun to Yehowah for his inspection.
- Hence Yehowah said to Moses; Take all the head ones of the people and **expose** them to Yehowah toward the sun, that the burning anger of Yehowah may turn back from Israel. (**Numbers 25:4**)
- Then Jonathan said; Here we are crossing over to the men, and let us **expose** ourselves to them. (**1 Samuel 14:8**)
- Let there be given to us seven men of his sons, and we must **expose** them to Yehowah in Gibeah of Saul, the chosen one of Yehowah. Accordingly the king said; I myself shall give them. (**2 Samuel 21:6**)
- Then he gave them into the hand of the Gibeonites and they proceeded to **expose** them on the mountain before Yehowah, so that the seven of them fell together, and they themselves were put to death in the first days of harvest, at the start of the barley harvest. (**2 Samuel 21:9**)
- Yehowah promised to come for and **expose** all the bloodshed of the land that his people had shed.
- For, look! Yehowah is coming forth from his place to call to account the error of the inhabitant of the land against him, and the land will certainly **expose** her bloodshed and will no longer cover over her killed ones. (**Isaiah 26:21**)
- Wicked Pharaoh used the power of the state wickedly to force the Israelite women to **expose** their infants to death.
- This one used statecraft against our race and wrongfully forced the fathers to **expose** their infants, that they might not be preserved alive. (**Acts of Apostles 7:19**)

- Those who have fallen away from Christ **expose** him to public shame by needing to come to him again for repentance.
- But who have fallen away, to revive them again to repentance, because they impale the Son of God afresh for themselves and **expose** him to public shame. (**Hebrews 6:6**)
