

~EXPRESSED (98)

- Jacob **expressed** more love for Rachel than for Leah.
- Then he had relations also with Rachel and also **expressed** more love for Rachel than for Leah, and he went serving with him for yet seven years more. (**Genesis 29:30**)
- Joseph's brothers **expressed** their father's command given before his death to Joseph.
- So they **expressed** a command to Joseph in these words; Your father gave the command before his death, saying; (**Genesis 50:16**)
- The mixed crowd of Israelites and Egyptians coming out of Egypt with Moses **expressed** selfish longing to return to Egypt.
- And the mixed crowd that was in the midst of them **expressed** selfish longing, and the sons of Israel too began to weep again and say; Who will give us meat to eat? (**Numbers 11:4**)
- Boaz felt that Ruth had **expressed** loving-kindness better than others, by not going after young men, or rich ones, but by accepting Yehowah God's repurchaser.
- At that he said; Blessed may you be of Yehowah, my daughter. You have **expressed** your loving-kindness better in the last instance than in the first instance, in not going after the young fellows whether lowly or rich. (**Ruth 3:10**)
- David **expressed** a personal craving for the waters of a well in Bethlehem, then under Philistine control.
- After a while David **expressed** his craving and said; O that I might have a drink of the water from the cistern of Bethlehem that is at the gate! (**2 Samuel 23:15**)
- Job showed, that he could maintain his patience because he **expressed** his concerns to God and not to man.

- As for me, is my concern **expressed** to man? Or why is it that my spirit does not get impatient? (**Job 21:4**)
- Yehowah God promised to react to the **expressed** hatred of Edom for his people.
- Therefore as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, I will act also according to your anger and according to your jealousy that you have **expressed** owing to your feelings of hatred toward them, and I will make myself known among them when I judge you. (**Ezekiel 35:11**)
- When the disciples of Jesus heard that no rich man would make no showing in heaven, they **expressed** very great surprise, asking; Who really can be saved?
- When the disciples heard that, they **expressed** very great surprise, saying; Who really can be saved? (**Matthew 19:25**)
- Paul **expressed** a desire for a man to go with him in his ministry, and they selected Timothy.
- Paul **expressed** the desire for this man to go out with him, and he took him and circumcised him because of the Jews that were in those places, for one and all knew that his father was a Greek. (**Acts of Apostles 16:3**)
- Early spirit anointed Christians **expressed** sympathy for their brothers who were in prison for preaching the Good News of God, and took the plundering of their own belongings joyfully.
- For you both **expressed** sympathy for those in prison and joyfully took the plundering of your belongings, knowing you yourselves have a better and an abiding possession. (**Hebrews 10:34**)
- Peter showed that spirit anointed Christians should use their gifts of the Holy Spirit as fine stewards of God's undeserved-kindness, each one **expressed** in his own way.
- In proportion as each one has received a gift, use it in ministering to one another as fine stewards of God's undeserved kindness **expressed** in various ways. (**1 Peter 4:10**)
