- The Psalmist made vows to Yehowah God and expressions of thanksgiving.
- Upon me, O God, there are vows to you. I shall render expressions of thanksgiving to you. (Psalms 56:12)
- The Psalmist said he would sing to time indefinite about the wonderful expressions of Yehowah God's loving-kindness through his Holy Spirit.
- Yehowah's expressions of loving-kindness I will sing about even to time indefinite. For generation after generation I shall make your faithfulness known with my mouth. (Psalms 89:1)
- The prostitute says to her lover, to come and enjoy each other's love expressions till morning.
- Do come, let us drink our fill of love until the morning, do let us enjoy each other with love expressions. (Proverbs 7:18)
- The shepherd boy found his lover's expressions to be better than wine or perfumed oils.
- May he kiss me with the kisses of his mouth, for your expressions of endearment are better than wine. (Song of Solomon 1:2)
- Draw me with you. Let us run. The king has brought me into his interior rooms! Do let us be joyful and rejoice in you. Do let us mention your expressions of endearment more than wine.

 Deservedly they have loved you. (Song of Solomon 1:4)
- How beautiful your expressions of endearment are, 0 my sister, my bride! How much better your expressions of endearment are than wine and the fragrance of your oils than all sorts of perfume! (Song of Solomon 4:10)
- I have come into my garden, O my sister, my bride. I have plucked my myrrh along with my spice. I have eaten my honeycomb along with my honey. I have drunk my wine along

- with my milk. Eat, O companions! Drink and become drunk with expressions of endearment! (Song of Solomon 5:1)
- Do let us rise early and go to the vineyards, that we may see whether the vine has sprouted, the blossom has burst open, the pomegranate trees have bloomed. There I shall give my expressions of endearment to you. (Song of Solomon 7:12)
- Yehowah God protected his people and when the time of love's expressions came upon them, as they matured, he took them as his wifely organization, and brought forth sons.
- Your time was the time for love's expressions. So I proceeded to spread my skirt over you and to cover your nudeness and to make a sworn statement to you and enter into a covenant with you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and so you became mine. (Ezekiel 16:8)
- The Israelites brought Babylonians into their bed of love's expressions, and defiled themselves with immoral intercourse.
- And the sons of Babylon kept coming in to her, to the bed of expressions of love, and defiling her with their immoral intercourse, and she continued getting defiled by them, and her soul began to turn away disgusted from them. (Ezekiel 23:17)
- Paul's public ministry to those spirit anointed Christians in Judea was not only to supply their wants, but to enable the Corinthians to be rich in many expressions of thanks toward Yehowah God.
- Because the ministry of this public service is not only to supply abundantly the wants of the holy ones but also to be rich with many expressions of thanks to God. (2 Corinthians 9:12)
- Peter warned of wicked men within the congregation who made swelling expressions of no profit, and who themselves followed after the desires of the flesh.
- For they utter swelling expressions of no profit, and by the desires of the flesh and by loose habits they entice those who are just escaping from people who conduct themselves in error. (2 Peter 2:18)

- John advised spirit anointed Christians not to believe every inspired expression, but to test them all out for truthfulness, for many false prophets had gone forth into the world.
- Beloved ones, do not believe every inspired expression, but test the inspired expressions to see whether they originate with God, because many false prophets have gone forth into the world. (1 John 4:1)
- In the Revelation vision John saw three unclean inspired expressions come out of the mouths of the dragon, the wild beast and the false prophet. These are expressions inspired by the demons and they gather together the nations to a war against Yehowah God.
- And I saw three unclean inspired expressions that looked like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the wild beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet. (Revelation 16:13)
- They are, in fact, expressions inspired by demons and perform signs, and they go forth to the kings of the entire inhabited earth, to gather them together to the war of the great day of God the Almighty. (Revelation 16:14)
- Yehowah is described as the God of the inspired expressions of the holy prophets of old, and is also the God who inspired Revelation.
- Yehowah the God of the inspired expressions of the prophets sent his angel forth to show his slaves the things that must shortly take place. (Revelation 22:6)
