[English, specifically, particularly, explicitly, clearly, freeway, definitely, deliberately]

- Daniel asked for time so that he could pray to Yehowah and then expressly reveal the matter of the king's dream.
- So Daniel himself went in and asked from the king that he should give him time expressly to show the very interpretation to the king. (Daniel 2:16)
- Jesus expressly told his disciples to watch out for the teachings of the Scribes and Pharisees.
- And he began to order them expressly and say; Keep your eyes open, look out for the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod. (Mark 8:15)
- He also expressly ordered them not to reveal to anyone about the transfiguration until after his death.
- As they were coming down out of the mountain, he expressly ordered them not to relate to anybody what they saw, until after the Son of man had risen from the dead. (Mark 9:9)
