~EXTERMINATE (120)

[English, kill, eliminate, annihilate, destroy, eradicate, wipe out, take out, decimate, massacre]

- Yehowah God wanted to exterminate Israel and make a great nation out of the man Moses, before Moses interceded for Israel.
- So now let me be, that my anger may blaze against them and I may exterminate them, and let me make you into a great nation. (Exodus 32:10)
- Moses reasoned that the Egyptians would say, that Yehowah God brought his people out into the wilderness only to exterminate them, if he did this.
- Why should the Egyptians say; With evil intent he brought them out in order to kill them among the mountains and to exterminate them from the surface of the ground? Turn from your burning anger and feel regret over the evil against your people. (Exodus 32:12)
- Yehowah God promised to bring Israel to a land flowing with milk and honey, but feared he might exterminate them, for they were a stiff-necked people.
- To a land flowing with milk and honey, for I shall not go up in the midst of you, because you are a stiff-necked people, that I may not exterminate you on the way. (Exodus 33:3)
- And Yehowah went on to say to Moses; Say to the sons of Israel, you are a stiff-necked people. In one moment I could go up into the midst of you and certainly exterminate you. So now put down your ornaments off yourself, as I want to know what I am going to do to you. (Exodus 33:5)
- Yehowah God later promised not to exterminate Israel, due to his covenant toward them.
- And yet for all this, while they continue in the land of their enemies, I shall certainly not reject them nor abhor them so as to exterminate them, to violate my covenant with them, for I am Yehowah their God. (Leviticus 26:44)

- Yehowah God told Moses to separate himself from the assembly, that he might exterminate them in an instant.
- Separate yourselves from the midst of this assembly, that I may exterminate them in an instant. (Numbers 16:21)
- You men, rise up from the midst of this assembly, that I may exterminate them in an instant. At this they fell upon their faces. (Numbers 16:45)
- Joshua warned that if Israel turned back against Yehowah that he would exterminate them after he had done good to them.
- In case you should leave Yehowah and you do serve foreign gods, he also will certainly turn back and do you injury and exterminate you after he has done you good. (Joshua 24:20)
- In David's song he said he would pursue his enemies and exterminate them.
- And I shall exterminate them and break them in pieces, that they may not rise up, and they will fall under my feet. (2 Samuel 22:39)
- Zedekiah made horns of iron as prophetic symbols, and said that with them, Israel would push the Syrians until they had exterminated them.
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and said; This is what Yehowah has said; With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (1 Kings 22:11)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and said; This is what Yehowah has said; With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (2 Chronicles 18:10)
- Because Israel failed to keep Yehowah God's Sabbaths and rebelled against him he promised to exterminate them.
- But they, the house of Israel, rebelled against me in the wilderness. In my statutes they did not walk, and my judicial decisions they rejected, which, should the man keep doing, he

will also keep living by them. And my Sabbaths they profaned very much, so that I promised to pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, in order to exterminate them. (Ezekiel 20:13)

- Through Ezekiel Yehowah God promised to exterminate Israel, and to bring their own way upon their heads.
- So I shall pour out my denunciation upon them. With the fire of my fury I will exterminate them. Their way I will bring upon their own head, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 22:31)
- Zechariah prophesied that Yehowah was sending forth a curse against the house of thieves and those swearing falsely to exterminate their very houses.
- I have caused it to go forth, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and it must enter into the house of the thief and into the house of the one making a sworn oath in my name falsely, and it must lodge in the midst of his house and exterminate it and its timbers and its stones. (Zechariah 5:4)
