

~EXTREMITIES (176)

[English, edges, limits, boundaries, furthest points, fringes, margins, ends]

- A copper grating was upon the altar with rings at its four **extremities**.
- And you must make a grating for it, a network of copper, and you must make upon the net four rings of copper at its four **extremities**. (Exodus 27:4)
- Then he cast four rings on the four **extremities** near the grating of copper, as supports for the poles. (Exodus 38:5)
- The ephod was to be joined at its two **extremities**, also the breastpiece of the High Priest.
- And it is to have two shoulder pieces to be joined at its two **extremities**, and it must be joined. (Exodus 28:7)
- And you must make upon the breastpiece two rings of gold, and you must put the two rings upon the two **extremities** of the breastpiece. (Exodus 28:23)
- And you must put the two ropes of gold through the two rings at the **extremities** of the breastpiece. (Exodus 28:24)
- And you must make two rings of gold and set them at the two **extremities** of the breastpiece upon its edge that is on the side toward the ephod inward. (Exodus 28:26)
- They made shoulder pieces for it that were joined. It was joined at its two **extremities**. (Exodus 39:4)
- Then they made two settings of gold and two rings of gold and put the two rings upon the two **extremities** of the breastpiece. (Exodus 39:16)
- After that they put the two ropes of gold through the two rings at the **extremities** of the breastpiece. (Exodus 39:17)
- Next they made two rings of gold and set them at the two

extremities of the breastpiece upon its edge that is on the side toward the ephod inward. ([Exodus 39:19](#))

- The Israelites were to make tassels on the four **extremities** of their clothing to distinguish themselves from others.
- You should make tassels for yourself on the four **extremities** of your clothing with which you cover yourself. ([Deuteronomy 22:12](#))
- Job showed that Yehowah God's lightnings were to the **extremities** of the earth.
- Under the whole heavens he lets it loose, and his lightning is to the **extremities** of the earth. ([Job 37:3](#))
- Job asked for Yehowah God to take control of the **extremities** of the earth, to shake out the wicked ones from it.
- To take hold on the **extremities** of the earth, that the wicked ones might be shaken out from it? ([Job 38:13](#))
- The sun goes forth from one **extremity** of heaven to its other **extremity**.
- From one extremity of the heavens is its going forth, and its finished circuit is to their other **extremities**, and there is nothing concealed from its heat. ([Psalms 19:6](#))
- Yehowah God will raise up a signal to collect the dispersed ones of his people from one **extremity** of the earth to the other.
- And he will certainly raise up a signal for the nations and gather the dispersed ones of Israel, and the scattered ones of Judah he will collect together from the four **extremities** of the earth. ([Isaiah 11:12](#))
- Yehowah is described as the creator of the **extremities** of the earth.
- Have you not come to know or have you not heard? Yehowah, the Creator of the **extremities** of the earth, is a God to time indefinite. He does not tire out or grow weary. There is no searching out of his understanding. ([Isaiah 40:28](#))

- **Isaiah prophesies, that when Yehowah God comes in judgment of the earth, that the islands were fearful, and the very **extremities** of the earth began trembling.**
- **The islands saw and began to fear. The very **extremities** of the earth began trembling. They drew near and kept coming. (**Isaiah 41:5**)**
- **Isaiah told Israel that Yehowah God had taken hold of his people from the **extremities** of the earth.**
- **You, whom I have taken hold of from the **extremities** of the earth, and you, whom I have called even from the remote parts of it. And so I said to you; You are my servant. I have chosen you, and I have not rejected you. (**Isaiah 41:9**)**
- **Yehowah God promised to bring in upon Elam four winds, from the four **extremities** of the earth.**
- **And I will bring in upon Elam the four winds from the four **extremities** of the heavens. And I will scatter them to all these winds, and there will prove to be no nation to which the dispersed ones of Elam will not come. (**Jeremiah 49:36**)**
- **Through Ezekiel Yehowah God promised to bring an end to the four **extremities** of their land.**
- **And as for you, O son of man, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the soil of Israel; An end, the end, has come upon the four **extremities** of the land. (**Ezekiel 7:2**)**
- **Peter beheld in vision a linen sheet being let down by its four **extremities**, filled with unclean animals to eat.**
- **And beheld heaven opened and some sort of vessel descending like a great linen sheet being let down by its four **extremities** upon the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 10:11**)**
- **I was in the city of Joppa praying, and in a trance I saw a vision, some sort of vessel descending like a great linen sheet being let down by its four **extremities** from heaven, and it came clear to me. (**Acts of Apostles 11:5**)**

- Paul showed that to the **extremities** of the inhabited earth the preaching of the Good News had gone forth so that no one could say they had not heard it.
- Nevertheless I ask, They did not fail to hear, did they? Why, in fact, into all the earth their sound went out, and to the **extremities** of the inhabited earth their utterances. (**Romans 10:18**)
