

~EXULTANT (53)

[English, jubilant, overjoyed, triumphant, thrilled, happy, elated, proud, Opposite of, miserable]

- The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God was the source of his exultant rejoicing.
- And I will come to the altar of God, to God, my **exultant** rejoicing. And I will laud you on the harp, O God, my God. (**Psalms 43:4**)
- The common grave of mankind, Sheol, has made room for even all the exultant ones of the earth.
- Therefore Sheol has made its soul spacious and has opened its mouth wide beyond bounds, and what is splendid in her, also her crowd and her uproar and the **exultant** one, will certainly go down into it. (**Isaiah 5:14**)
- Yehowah brings in eminently exultant ones of the nations to express his anger against his rebellious people.
- I myself have issued the command to my sanctified ones. I have also called my mighty ones for expressing my anger, my eminently **exultant** ones. (**Isaiah 13:3**)
- Jerusalem was referred to as an exultant town whose slain ones were not slain in warfare.
- With turmoil you were full, a boisterous city, an **exultant** town. Your slain ones are not those slain with the sword, nor those dead in battle. (**Isaiah 22:2**)
- Is this your city that was **exultant** from days of long ago, from her early times? Her feet used to bring her far away to reside as an alien. (**Isaiah 23:7**)
- This is the **exultant** city that was sitting in security, that was saying in her heart, I am, and there is nobody else. O how she has become an object of astonishment, a place for the wild animals to lie stretched out! Everyone passing along by her will whistle, he will wag his hand. (**Zephaniah 2:15**)

- **Yehowah promised to remove her haughtily exultant ones so that they would never again act haughtily in his holy mountain.**
- **In that day you will not be ashamed because of all your dealings with which you transgressed against me, for then I shall remove from the midst of you your haughtily **exultant** ones, and you will never again be haughty in my holy mountain. (**Zephaniah 3:11**)**
