

~EXULTS (31)

[English, revels, takes pride, gloats, glories, triumphs, wallows, rejoices, Opposite of, laments]

- Yehowah speaks of Leviathan or Hippopotamus, as a beast that exults in power.
- It paws in the low plain and **exults** in power, it goes forth to meet armor. (Job 39:21)
- A mighty man **exults** in running confidently in a path.
- And it is like a bridegroom when coming out of his nuptial chamber, it **exults** as a mighty man does to run in a path. (Psalms 19:5)
- The Psalmist trusted in Yehowah explicitly and his heart exulted in him all day long.
- Yehowah is my strength and my shield. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart **exults**, and with my song I shall laud him. (Psalms 28:7)
- James showed that mercy exults or wins out over judgment every time. It is simply better to be merciful.
- For the one that does not practice mercy will have his judgment without mercy. Mercy **exults** triumphantly over judgment. (James 2:13)
