- The Psalmist felt that his life was like one without water in a dry and thirsty land.
- O God, you are my God, I keep looking for you. My soul does thirst for you. For you my flesh has grown faint with longing In a land dry and exhausted, where there is no water. (Psalms 63:1)
- The Psalmist showed concern for God and his way that his own spirit might not fade away.
- I will remember God and be boisterous. I will show concern, that my spirit may faint away. (Psalms 77:3)
- The Psalmist shows that when men are lacking food and water they grow faint.
- They were hungry, also thirsty, their very soul within them began to faint away. (Psalms 107:5)
- Jesus showed that men would become faint out of fear and the expectation of what was to come upon the world during the time of the end.
- While men become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Luke 21:26)
