- The one **faithless** at heart is self satisfied, not caring about Yehowah and his standards and what he thinks of the man.
- The one **faithless** at heart will be satisfied with the results of his own ways, but the good man with the results of his dealings. (Proverbs 14:14)
- Jesus called the generation that he lived through a **faithless** and twisted generation difficult for him to deal with for he was a man of faith.
- In reply Jesus said; O **faithless** and twisted generation, how long must I continue with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring him here to me. (Matthew 17:17)
- In response he said to them; O **faithless** generation, how long must I continue with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring him to me. (Mark 9:19)
- In response Jesus said; O **faithless** and twisted generation, how long must I continue with you and put up with you? Lead your son over here. (Luke 9:41)

- All things are clean to clean persons. But to persons defiled and **faithless** nothing is clean, but both their minds and their consciences are defiled. (Titus 1:15)
