## ~FALSEHOOD (450)

[English, dishonesty, deceit, lies, fabrication, mendacity, deception, Opposite of, honesty]

- Israelites were never to testify to a falsehood.
- Neither must you testify to a falsehood against your fellowman.
   (Deuteronomy 5:20)
- Job called his three companions smearers of falsehood, like physicians of no value, for they were not comforting him by their false words.
- On the other hand, you men are smearers of falsehood, all of you are physicians of no value. (Job 13:4)
- Job showed that his own words contained no falsehoods.
- For my words are for a fact no falsehood, the One perfect in knowledge is with you. (Job 36:4)
- The Psalmist warned of men who are pregnant with what is hurtful, who can only give birth to falsehood.
- Look! There is one that is pregnant with what is hurtful, and he has conceived trouble and is bound to give birth to falsehood. (Psalms 7:14)
- The Psalmist reproved men who loved what is bad, more than good, and falsehood rather than righteousness.
- You have loved what is bad more than what is good, falsehood more than speaking righteousness. (Psalms 52:3)
- The Psalmist showed, that the mouth of everyone speaking falsehood, will be stopped up.
- And the king himself will rejoice in God. Every one swearing by him will boast, for the mouth of those speaking falsehood will be stopped up. (Psalms 63:11)

- The Psalmist complained to his God about men who spoke falsehood against him.
- For the mouth of the wicked one and the mouth of deception have opened against me. They have spoken about me with the tongue of falsehood. (Psalms 109:2)
- The Psalmist showed that the presumptuous men had smeared his reputation through falsehoods.
- The presumptuous have smeared me with falsehood. As for me, with all my heart I shall observe your orders. (Psalms 119:69)
- Yehowah God has tossed away all those straying from him, for their trickiness is just falsehood.
- You have tossed away all those straying from your regulations, for their trickiness is falsehood. (Psalms 119:118)
- The Psalmist, like his God Yehowah, hated falsehood, even detesting it, but Yehowah God's Law he loved.
- Falsehood I have hated, and I do keep detesting it. Your Law I have loved. (Psalms 119:163)
- The mouth of the wicked ones speaks what is untrue, and they carry falsehood in their right hand.
- Whose mouth has spoken what is untrue and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood. (Psalms 144:8)
- Where one tries to cover over hatred, there are lips of falsehood.
- Where there is one covering over hatred there are lips of falsehood, and the one bringing forth a bad report is stupid. (Proverbs 10:18)
- The tongue dealings out falsehood will last only at long as a moment.
- It is the lip of truth that will be firmly established forever, but the tongue of falsehood will be only as long as a moment. (Proverbs 12:19)

- The lip of falsehood is not befitting for nobles.
- For anyone senseless the lip of uprightness is not fitting. How much less so for a noble the lip of falsehood! (Proverbs 17:7)
- A man may find pleasure in obtaining bread through falsehood, but afterwards it will be like he is trying to eat gravel.
- Bread gained by falsehood is pleasurable to a man, but afterward his mouth will be filled with gravel. (Proverbs 20:17)
- A man boasting about a gift in falsehood, is like stormclouds without rain.
- As vaporous clouds and a wind without any downpour is a man boasting himself about a gift in falsehood. (Proverbs 25:14)
- Isaiah warned Israelites who had made a falsehood their refuge, that Yehowah God would sweep away their lies, and reveal all the truth about them to others.
- Because you men have said; We have concluded a covenant with Death, and with Sheol we have effected a vision, the overflowing flash flood, in case it should pass through, will not come to us, for we have made a lie our refuge and in falsehood we have concealed ourselves. (Isaiah 28:15)
- The man who makes and worships idols is feeding upon ashes, and he does not realize, that he holds a falsehood in his right hand.
- He is feeding on ashes. His own heart that has been trifled with has led him astray. And he does not deliver his soul, nor does he say; Is there not a falsehood in my right hand? (Isaiah 44:20)
- Isaiah called his countrymen the children of transgression and the seed of falsehood.
- Over whom is it that you have a jolly good time? Against whom do you keep opening wide the mouth, keep sticking out the tongue? Are you not the children of transgression, the seed of falsehood. (Isaiah 57:4)
- Isaiah showed, that his people had spoken falsehood, muttering sheer unrighteousness.

- For your own palms have become polluted with blood, and your fingers with error. Your own lips have spoken falsehood. Your own tongue kept muttering sheer unrighteousness. (Isaiah 59:3)
- Isaiah showed, that Yehowah God's people had conceived revolt and oppression, and kept muttering words of falsehood from the very heart.
- There have been transgressing and a denying of Yehowah, and there was a moving back from our God, a speaking of oppression and revolt, a conceiving and a muttering of words of falsehood from the very heart. (Isaiah 59:13)
- Jeremiah showed that the governments of men belong to falsehood, for only in Yehowah God does salvation lie.
- Truly the hills as well as the turmoil on the mountains belong to falsehood. Truly in Yehowah our God is the salvation of Israel. (Jeremiah 3:23)
- Yehowah God, they would be swearing to sheer falsehood.
- Even if they should say; As Yehowah is alive! They would thereby be swearing to sheer falsehood. (Jeremiah 5:2)
- Jeremiah showed, that in his day the prophets prophesied in falsehood, and the people came to love it that way, and followed after them joyfully to their own destruction.
- The prophets themselves actually prophesy in falsehood, and as for the priests, they go subduing according to their powers. And my own people have loved it that way, and what will you men do in the finale of it? (Jeremiah 5:31)
- Jeremiah counseled men who thought they were serving Yehowah God acceptably, that the false stylus of the secretaries had worked sheer falsehood in them.
- How can you men say; We are wise, and the Law of Yehowah is with us? Surely, now, the false stylus of the secretaries has worked in sheer falsehood. (Jeremiah 8:8)

- Jeremiah showed, that the false prophets bent their tongue like a bow in falsehood, going forth from badness to badness, ignoring Yehowah their God.
- And they bend their tongue as their bow in falsehood, but not for faithfulness have they proved mighty in the land. For from badness to badness they went forth, and they ignored even me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 9:3)
- Jeremiah showed, that people of Israel in his day had taught their tongues to speak only falsehood.
- And they keep trifling each one with his companion, and they speak no truth at all. They have taught their tongue to speak falsehood. They have tired themselves out merely in doing wrong. (Jeremiah 9:5)
- The idol image a metalworker makes, is a falsehood, for there is no spirit in them, for they are all un-living.
- Every man has behaved so unreasoningly as not to know. Every metalworker will certainly feel shame because of the carved image, for his molten image is a falsehood, and there is no spirit in them. (Jeremiah 10:14)
- Every man has behaved so unreasoningly as not to know. Every metalworker will feel ashamed because of the carved image, for his molten image is a falsehood, and there is no spirit in them. (Jeremiah 51:17)
- Of what benefit has a carved image been, when the former of it has carved it, a molten statue, and an instructor in falsehood? when the former of its form has trusted in it, to the extent of making valueless gods that are speechless? (Habakkuk 2:18)
- Jeremiah showed the men of Israel, what their measured portion would be from Yehowah God, since they kept putting their trust in falsehood.
- This is your lot, your measured portion from me, is the utterance of Yehowah, because you have forgotten me and you keep putting your trust in falsehood. (Jeremiah 13:25)

- Jeremiah showed that the prophets of Jerusalem were prophesying in falsehood, for Yehowah God had not commanded them to speak any message to the people.
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- Jeremiah showed that Israel would come to realize that their own forefathers had come to possess sheer falsehood, vain things that were not beneficial.
- O Yehowah my strength and my stronghold, and my place for flight in the day of distress, to you the nations themselves will come from the ends of the earth, and they will say; Indeed our forefathers came to possess sheer falsehood, vanity and things in which there was nothing beneficial. (Jeremiah 16:19)
- Pashhur came to ruin because he spoke and prophesied in Yehowah God's name in falsehood.
- And as for you, O Pashhur, and all the inhabitants of your house, you will go into captivity, and to Babylon you will come and there you will die and there you yourself will be buried with all your lovers, because you have prophesied to them in falsehood.

  (Jeremiah 20:6)
- Jeremiah saw in the prophets of Jerusalem terrible things, like committing adultery and walking in falsehood.
- And in the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen horrible things, committing adultery and walking in falsehood, and they have strengthened the hands of evildoers in order, that they should not return, each one from his own badness. To me all of them have become like Sodom, and the inhabitants of her like Gomorrah. (Jeremiah 23:14)
- Yehowah called to account the false prophets who said they had received a divinely given dream, but who were prophesying in his name a falsehood.
- I have heard what the prophets who are prophesying falsehood

in my own name have said; Saying; I have had a dream! I have had a dream! (Jeremiah 23:25)

- Jeremiah said that the prophets of Jerusalem were prophesying in falsehood, according to the trickiness of their own hearts. They tried to fool Israelites into thinking that Babylon would not overtake Judah.
- How long will it exist in the heart of the prophets who are prophesying the falsehood and who are prophets of the trickiness of their own heart? (Jeremiah 23:26)
- For falsehood is what they are prophesying to you, for the purpose of having you taken far away from off your ground, and I shall have to disperse you, and you will have to perish.

  (Jeremiah 27:10)
- And do not listen to the words of the prophets that are saying to you men, you will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:14)
- And to the priests and to all this people I spoke, saying; This is what Yehowah has said; Do not listen to the words of your prophets that are prophesying to you, saying; Look! The utensils of the house of Yehowah are being brought back from Babylon soon now! For falsehood is what they are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:16)
- And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood. (Jeremiah 28:15)
- For it is in falsehood that they are prophesying to you in my name. I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:9)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said concerning Ahab the son of Kolaiah and to Zedekiah the son of Maaseiah, who are prophesying to you falsehood in my own name, Here I am giving them into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, and he must strike them down before your eyes. (Jeremiah 29:21)
- Send to all the exiled people, saying; This is what Yehowah has

said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah has prophesied to you people, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make you trust in falsehood. (Jeremiah 29:31)

- Gedeliah refused to believe that Ishmael was trying to kill him, saying that it was a falsehood.
- But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam said to Johanan the son of Kareah; Do not do this thing, for it is a falsehood that you are speaking concerning Ishmael. (Jeremiah 40:16)
- Azariah the son of Hoshaiah and Johanan the son of Kareah and all the presumptuous men proceeded to say to Jeremiah; It is a falsehood that you are speaking. Yehowah our God has not sent you, saying; Do not enter into Egypt to reside there as aliens. (Jeremiah 43:2)
- Ezekiel showed that men were dejecting the hearts of righteous ones with falsehoods.
- By reason of dejecting the heart of a righteous one with falsehood, when I myself had not caused him pain, and for making the hands of a wicked one strong so that he would not turn back from his bad way in order to preserve him alive. (Ezekiel 13:22)
- Hosea showed that Yehowah God knew that Ephraim and Samaria had practiced falsehoods.
- At the time that I would bring healing to Israel, the error of Ephraim is also actually uncovered, and the bad things of Samaria, for they have practiced falsehood, and a thief himself comes in, a marauder band actually makes a dash on the outside. (Hosea 7:1)
- A man who walks by wind and falsehood is a liar.
- If a man, walking by wind and falsehood, has told the lie. I shall let words drop to you concerning wine and concerning intoxicating liquor, he also will certainly become the one letting words drop for this people. (Micah 2:11)

- Micah showed that the men of Israel had become full of violence and spoken falsehood.
- For her own rich men have become full of violence, and her own inhabitants have spoken falsehood, and their tongue is tricky in their mouth. (Micah 6:12)
- Zechariah showed that the false prophets had spoken falsehood, and valueless dreams are what they keep speaking.
- For the teraphim themselves have spoken what is uncanny, and the practicers of divination, for their part, have visioned falsehood, and valueless dreams are what they keep speaking, and in vain they try to comfort. That is why they will certainly depart like a flock, they will become afflicted, because there is no shepherd. (Zechariah 10:2)
- And it must occur that in case a man should prophesy anymore, his father and his mother, the ones who caused his birth, must also say to him; You will not live, because falsehood is what you have spoken in the name of Yehowah. And his father and his mother, the ones who caused his birth, must pierce him through because of his prophesying. (Zechariah 13:3)
- Paul counseled Christians, that now that they have put away falsehood, they should speak truth each one with his neighbor.
- Wherefore, now that you have put away falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, because we are members belonging to one another. (Ephesians 4:25)
- The ones chosen for the first resurrection and heavenly life alongside of Yehowah God and his Christ, have no falsehoods found within their mouths. They are without blemish before their God.
- And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (Revelation 14:5)
