[English, incorrectly, wrong, untruly, mistakenly, fallaciously, erroneously, Opposite of, rightly]

- Israelites must not testify falsely.
- You must not testify falsely as a witness against your fellowman. (Exodus 20:16)
- Or he does find something lost and is actually deceptive about it and does swear falsely over any of all the things that the man might do to sin by them. (Leviticus 6:3)
- Or anything at all over which he might swear falsely, and he must make compensation for it in its full amount, and he will add to it a fifth of it. To the one whose it is he will give it on the day his guilt is proved. (Leviticus 6:5)
- You people must not steal, and you must not deceive, and you must not deal falsely anyone with his associate. (Leviticus 19:11)
- The Psalmist showed that Israel forgot their God and acted falsely toward his covenant.
- All this is what has come upon us, and we have not forgotten you, and we have not acted falsely in your covenant. (Psalms 44:17)
- Jeremiah showed that among Judah's religious leaders each one was acting falsely.
- For from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, every one is making for himself unjust gain, and from the prophet even to the priest, each one is acting falsely. (Jeremiah 6:13)
- Therefore I shall give their wives to other men, their fields to those taking possession, for, from the least one even to the greatest one, each one is making unjust gain, from the prophet even to the priest, each one is acting falsely. (Jeremiah 8:10)

- Can men claiming to worship Yehowah God in truth, be swearing falsely, and doing any of the other things listed below? Certainly not!
- Can there be stealing, murdering and committing adultery and swearing falsely and making sacrificial smoke to Baal and walking after other gods whom you had not known. (Jeremiah 7:9)
- Yehowah God did not send the false prophets who were speaking falsely in his name.
- For I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah, but they are prophesying in my name falsely, to the end that I shall disperse you, and you will have to perish, you men and the prophets that are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:15)
- For the reason that they have carried on senselessness in Israel, and they keep committing adultery with the wives of their companions and keep speaking falsely in my own name the word that I did not command them. And I am the One knowing and am a witness, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:23)
- Yehowah God caused a curse to enter into the houses of everyone speaking falsely a sworn oath, and of any thief.
- I have caused it to go forth, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and it must enter into the house of the thief and into the house of the one making a sworn oath in my name falsely, and it must lodge in the midst of his house and exterminate it and its timbers and its stones. (Zechariah 5:4)
- Yehowah God promised to become a speedy witness against anyone swearing falsely.
- And I will come near to you people for the judgment, and I will become a speedy witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against those swearing falsely, and against those acting fraudulently with the wages of a wage worker, with the widow and with the fatherless boy, and those turning away the alien resident, while they have not feared me, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 3:5)
- Jesus told those in military service not to accuse anyone falsely.

- Also, those in military service would ask him; What shall we also do? And he said to them; Do not harass anybody or accuse anybody falsely, but be satisfied with your provisions. (Luke 3:14)
- Some men falsely charged spirit anointed Christians with doing bad things, so that the good thing might come in, this is very much against Christian teachings.
- And why not say; Just as it is falsely charged to us and just as some men state that we say; Let us do the bad things that the good things may come? The judgment against those men is in harmony with justice. (Romans 3:8)
- Paul counseled Timothy to turn away from the falsely called knowledge, which is full of contradictions.
- O Timothy, guard what is laid up in trust with you, turning away from the empty speeches that violate what is holy and from the contradictions of the falsely called, knowledge. (1 Timothy 6:20)
