## ~FEARS (51)

[English, doubts, qualms, worries, uncertainties, reservations, suspicions]

- The man who truly fears to displease Yehowah is the one who gets his blessing.
- Look! That is how the able-bodied man will be blessed who fears Yehowah. (Psalms 128:4)
- The wise persons has a fear of displeasing Yehowah and so turns away from badness.
- The wise one fears and is turning away from badness, but the stupid is becoming furious and self-confident. (Proverbs 14:16)
- A woman also who fears Yehowah will procure praise for herself.
- Charm may be false, and prettiness may be vain, but the woman that fears Yehowah is the one that procures praise for herself. (Proverbs 31:30)
- The wicked must be taken hold of to restrain them but the foolish one also needs to be restrained. The one that fears God will go forth with both of them.
- Do not be wicked overmuch, nor become foolish. Why should you die when it is not your time? (Ecclesiastes 7:17)
- It is better that you should take hold of the one, but from the other also do not withdraw your hand, for he that fears God will go forth with them all. (Ecclesiastes 7:18)
- God is not partial to any race of men but in every nation the man that fears him is acceptable to him.
- But in every nation the man that fears him and works righteousness is acceptable to him. (Acts of Apostles 10:35)
- Paul showed that as he traveled to new lands in his preaching assignment there were numerous occasions of fights without and fears within.

In fact, when we arrived in Macedonia, our flesh got no relief, but we continued to be afflicted in every this, there were fights without, fears within. (2 Corinthians 7:5)
