- Jacob's sons **feelings** were offended, by what was done to their sister Dinah.
- And the sons of Jacob came in from the field as soon as they heard of it, and the men became hurt in their **feelings** and they grew very angry, because he had committed a disgraceful folly against Israel in lying down with Jacob's daughter, whereas nothing like that ought to be done. (**Genesis 34:7**)
- David did not want to hurt the **feelings** of Adonijah by stopping him from thinking that he would become king after his father.
- And his father did not hurt his **feelings** at any time by saying, Why is this the way you have done? And he was also very good-looking in form, and his mother had borne him after Absalom. (**1 Kings 1:6**)
- Since Seir or Edom, acted with **feelings** of hatred toward Israel and Judah Yehowah swore that he would let the Israelites see the judgment of Edom.
- Therefore as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, I will act also according to your anger and according to your jealousy that you have expressed owing to your **feelings** of hatred toward them, and I will make myself known among them when I judge you. (**Ezekiel 35:11**)
- Elijah the prophet was a man with **feelings** like everyone else, yet in prayer he prayed for it not to rain and it did not rain for three and one half years.
- Elijah was a man with **feelings** like ours, and yet in prayer he prayed for it not to rain, and it did not rain upon the land for three years and six months. (**James 5:17**)
