- Yehowah promised to bring in upon his people for their disobedience a people fierce in countenance who would show them no favor.
- A nation fierce in countenance, who will not be partial to an old man or show favor to a young man. (Deuteronomy 28:50)
- Daniel's vision of the last days show that a king would arise fierce in countenance.
- And in the final part of their kingdom, as the transgressors act to a completion, there will stand up a king fierce in countenance and understanding ambiguous sayings. (Daniel 8:23)
- Jesus encountered two fierce men among the tombs, men so fierce that no one had the courage to pass by that way.
- When he got to the other side, into the country of the Gadarenes, there met him two demon-possessed men coming out from among the memorial tombs, unusually fierce, so that nobody had the courage to pass by on that road. (Matthew 8:28)
- Paul showed that in the last days men would be fierce, without love of goodness.
- Having no natural affection, not open to any agreement,
 slanderers, without self-control, fierce, without love of goodness.
