[English, violent, ferocious, severe, brutal, stern, angry, vicious, furious, Opposite of, gentle]

- Yehowah promised to bring in upon his people for their disobedience a people **fierce** in countenance who would show them no favor.
- A nation **fierce** in countenance, who will not be partial to an old man or show favor to a young man. (**Deuteronomy 28:50**)
- Daniel's vision of the last days show that a king would arise **fierce** in countenance.
- And in the final part of their kingdom, as the transgressors act to a completion, there will stand up a king **fierce** in countenance and understanding ambiguous sayings. (**Daniel 8:23**)
- Jesus encountered two **fierce** men among the tombs, men so **fierce** that no one had the courage to pass by that way.
- When he got to the other side, into the country of the Gadarenes, there met him two demon-possessed men coming out from among the memorial tombs, unusually **fierce**, so that nobody had the courage to pass by on that road. (**Matthew 8:28**)
- Paul showed that in the last days men would be **fierce**, without love of goodness.
- Having no natural affection, not open to any agreement, slanderers, without self-control, **fierce**, without love of goodness. (**2 Timothy 3:3**)
