[English, dirty, grubby, grimy, mucky, soiled, grubby, Opposite of, clean]

- Isaiah describes those who had left clean principles like justice as **filthy** in God's eyes.
- For the tables themselves have all become full of **filthy** vomit, there is no place without it. (**Isaiah 28:8**)
- James showed that there should not be class distinctions among Christians of differing economic status.
- For, if a man with gold rings on his fingers and in splendid clothing enters into a gathering of you, but a poor man in **filthy** clothing also enters. (**James 2:2**)
- Revelation shows that a time would then pass where people would be allowed to be what they really wanted to be without interference, to demonstrate what kind of people they really were.
- He that is doing unrighteousness, let him do unrighteousness still, and let the **filthy** one be made **filthy** still, but let the righteous one do righteousness still, and let the holy one be made holy still. (**Revelation 22:11**)
