- When God finished speaking to Abraham he departed from him.
- With that God finished speaking with him and went up from Abraham. (Genesis 17:22)
- Yehowah God warned Abraham of the impending action against Sodom and Gomorrah, and when he had finished speaking Abraham returned to his place.
- Then Yehowah went his way when he had finished speaking to Abraham, and Abraham returned to his place. (Genesis 18:33)
- Before Abraham's servant finished speaking, Rebekah came up with her water jar upon her shoulder. When she was finished giving him a drink, she also offered to water his camels.
- Well, it came about that before he had finished speaking, why, here coming out was Rebekah, who had been born to Bethuel the son of Milcah the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, and her water jar was upon her shoulder. (Genesis 24:15)
- When she was finished giving him a drink, then she said; For your camels too I shall draw water until they are done drinking.
 (Genesis 24:19)
- Consequently it came about that, when the camels had finished drinking, then the man took a gold nose ring of a half shekel in weight and two bracelets for her hands, ten shekels of gold was their weight. (Genesis 24:22)
- Before I was finished speaking in my heart, why, there was Rebekah coming out, with her jar upon her shoulder, and she made her way down to the fountain and began to draw water. Then I said to her; Give me a drink, please. (Genesis 24:45)
- After Isaac had finished blessing Jacob, Esau returned seeking his blessing.

- Now it came about as soon as Isaac had finished blessing Jacob, yes, it indeed came about when Jacob had barely come out from before the face of Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came back from his hunting. (Genesis 27:30)
- When Jacob's sons finished eating the foodstuffs of their first trip to Egypt, their father asked them to return to buy more.
- And it came about that as soon as they had finished eating up the cereals they had brought from Egypt, their father proceeded to say to them; Return, buy a little food for us. (Genesis 43:2)
- Joseph's servant went searching carefully through his brother's possessions from oldest to youngest, looking for Joseph's cup.
- And he went searching carefully. He started with the oldest and finished with the youngest. At last the cup was found in Benjamin's bag. (Genesis 44:12)
- When Jacob finished giving commands to his sons he expired.
- Thus Jacob finished giving commands to his sons. Then he gathered his feet up onto the couch and expired and was gathered to his people. (Genesis 49:33)
- When Yehowah God finished speaking to Moses on Mount Sinai he gave him the tablets of the testimony, written on by God's finger upon stone.
- Now as soon as he had finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai he proceeded to give Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone written on by God's finger. (Exodus 31:18)
- Moses finished all the work of the tabernacle according to Yehowah God's instructions.
- Finally he set up the courtyard round about the tabernacle and the altar and put up the screen of the gate of the courtyard. So Moses finished the work. (Exodus 40:33)
- When the High Priest finished making atonement for the holy place, then he must present the live goat.
- When he has finished making atonement for the holy place and

the tent of meeting and the altar, he must also present the live goat. (Leviticus 16:20)

- On the day that Moses finished setting up the tabernacle he anointed and sanctified it.
- Now it came about on the day that Moses finished setting up the tabernacle that he proceeded to anoint it and to sanctify it and all its furnishings and the altar and all its utensils. Thus he anointed them and sanctified them. (Numbers 7:1)
- When Moses finished speaking all these words then the ground under those rebels began to split apart.
- And it came about that as soon as he had finished speaking all these words, the ground that was under them began to be split apart. (Numbers 16:31)
- After all the registered men of war who refused to enter the Promised Land died, coming to their finish.
- And it came about that as soon as all the men of war had finished dying off from the midst of the people. (Deuteronomy 2:16)
- The officers after having finished speaking to the people of Israel, were to appoint chiefs of the armies at the head of the people.
- And it must occur that when the officers have finished speaking to the people, they must also appoint chiefs of the armies at the head of the people. (Deuteronomy 20:9)
- Moses died shortly after he finished writing the book of the Law.
- And it came about that as soon as Moses had finished writing the words of this Law in a book until their completion. (Deuteronomy 31:24)
- After Moses finished speaking all these words to all Israel. (Deuteronomy 32:45)
- Joshua finished slaughtering the men of Canaan with a great slaughter, per Yehowah God's command.
- And it came about that as soon as Joshua and the sons of Israel

had finished slaying them with a very great slaughter, until these came to their end, and those who did survive of them escaped and went entering into the fortified cities. (Joshua 10:20)

- The Israelites under Joshua finished dividing the land by its territories.
- Thus they finished dividing the land for a possession by its territories. Then the sons of Israel gave an inheritance to Joshua the son of Nun in their midst. (Joshua 19:49)
- When he had finished presenting the tribute, he sent those bringing it, away.
- And it came about that when he had finished presenting the tribute, he at once sent the people away, the bearers of the tribute. (Judges 3:18)
- Sampson when **finished** defeating the Philistines threw the jawbone away.
- And it came about that when he finished speaking, he immediately threw the jawbone out of his hand and called that place Ramath-lehi. (Judges 15:17)
- Ruth told Naomi her mother-in-law that Boaz told her to glean close by his young people, until she had finished the entire harvest.
- Then Ruth the Moabitess said; He also said to me; Close by the young people that are mine is where you should keep until they have finished the entire harvest that I have. (Ruth 2:21)
- Naomi told Ruth not to make herself known to Boaz until after he had finished eating and drinking after the day's work was over.
- And you must wash and rub yourself with oil and put your mantles upon you and go down to the threshing floor. Do not make yourself known to the man until he has finished eating and drinking. (Ruth 3:3)
- Saul at last finished speaking as a prophet, and came to the high place.
- At length he finished speaking as a prophet and came to the high

place. (1 Samuel 10:13)

- Saul when he had just finished offering up a sacrifice by himself, saw Samuel coming in.
- And it came about that as soon as he had finished offering up the burnt sacrifice, why, there was Samuel coming in. So Saul went out to meet him and bless him. (1 Samuel 13:10)
- After Jonathan finished speaking with Saul his father, then his soul became bound up with David's soul.
- And it came about that, as soon as he had finished speaking to Saul, Jonathan's very soul became bound up with the soul of David, and Jonathan began to love him as his own soul. (1 Samuel 18:1)
- When David finished speaking to Saul, then Saul asked if it was the voice of David.
- And it came about that, at the moment that David finished speaking these words to Saul, Saul proceeded to say; Is this your voice, my son David? And Saul began to raise his own voice and weep. (1 Samuel 24:16)
- When David finished offering the burnt sacrifices and the communion sacrifices then he blessed the people in the name of Yehowah their God.
- When David was finished with offering up the burnt sacrifices and the communion sacrifices, he then blessed the people in the name of Yehowah of armies. (2 Samuel 6:18)
- When David finished offering up the burnt offering and the communion sacrifices, he went on to bless the people in the name of Yehowah. (1 Chronicles 16:2)
- Adonijah got to hear of it, when he had finished eating.
- And Adonijah and all the ones invited that were with him got to hear it, when they themselves had finished eating. When Joab got to hear the sound of the horn, he at once said; What does the noise of the town in an uproar mean? (1 Kings 1:41)

- Solomon brought the daughter of Pharaoh to the city of David, until he **finished** building his own house.
- And Solomon proceeded to form a marriage alliance with Pharaoh the king of Egypt and to take Pharaoh's daughter and bring her to the City of David, until he finished building his own house and the house of Yehowah and Jerusalem's wall all around. (1 Kings 3:1)
- In the eleventh year of Solomon's reign the house of Yehowah God was finished as regards all its details, according to its plan.
- And in the eleventh year, in the lunar month of Bul, that is, the eighth month, the house was finished as regards all its details and all its plan, so that he was seven years at building it. (1 Kings 6:38)
- Solomon finished his own house after thirteen years.
- And his own house Solomon built in thirteen years, so that he finished all his own house. (1 Kings 7:1)
- Hiram at length finished all the work that Solomon had requested of him for the house of Yehowah God.
- And Hiram gradually made the basins and the shovels and the bowls. At length Hiram finished doing all the work that he did for King Solomon as respects the house of Yehowah. (1 Kings 7:40)
- Finally Hiram made the cans and the shovels and the bowls. So Hiram finished doing the work that he did for King Solomon on the house of the true God. (2 Chronicles 4:11)
- As soon as Solomon finished praying to Yehowah God at the temple dedication, from bending down at his knees with his palms spread out to the heavens, fire came down from heaven consuming the burnt offerings.
- And it came about that, as soon as Solomon finished praying to Yehowah with all this prayer and request for favor, he rose up from before the altar of Yehowah, from bending down upon his knees with his palms spread out to the heavens. (1 Kings 8:54)
- Now as soon as Solomon finished praying, the fire itself came

down from the heavens and proceeded to consume the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and Yehowah's glory itself filled the house. (2 Chronicles 7:1)

- In time Solomon finished all his building works of the temple and his own house.
- And it came about that, as soon as Solomon had finished building the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and every desirable thing of Solomon that he took delight in making. (1 Kings 9:1)
- Thus Solomon finished the house of Yehowah and the house of the king, and in everything that had come into Solomon's heart to do regarding the house of Yehowah and his own house he proved successful. (2 Chronicles 7:11)
- So Solomon's work was all in a prepared state from the day of the foundation-laying of the house of Yehowah until it was finished. So the house of Yehowah was complete. (2 Chronicles 8:16)
- Jehu authorized the killing of the Baal priests as soon as he finished rendering up the burnt offering.
- And it came about that as soon as he finished rendering up the burnt offering, Jehu immediately said to the runners and the adjutants; Come in, strike them down! Do not let a single one go out. And the runners and the adjutants began to strike them down with the edge of the sword and to throw them out, and they kept going as far as the city of the house of Baal. (2 Kings 10:25)
- David told Solomon that Yehowah God would not leave him until after he had finished the work of the service of Yehowah God's house.
- And David went on to say to Solomon his son; Be courageous and strong and act. Do not be afraid nor be terrified, for Yehowah God, my God, is with you. He will not desert you or leave you until all the work of the service of Yehowah's house is finished. (1 Chronicles 28:20)
- After they finished with the inhabitants of Seir, the Ammonites and Moabites brought one another to ruin.

- And the sons of Ammon and Moab proceeded to stand up against the inhabitants of the mountainous region of Seir to devote them to destruction and annihilate them, and as soon as they finished with the inhabitants of Seir, they helped each one to bring his own fellow to ruin. (2 Chronicles 20:23)
- As soon as they finished with the structural improvements to Yehowah God's house of worship, they brought the rest of the money to the king to make utensils for the house of Yehowah.
- And as soon as they had finished they brought before the king and Jehoiada the rest of the money, and they proceeded to make utensils for the house of Yehowah, utensils for the ministry and for making offerings and cups and utensils of gold and of silver, and they came to be offerers of burnt sacrifices in the house of Yehowah constantly all the days of Jehoiada. (2 Chronicles 24:14)
- When the temple was sanctified it took 8 days to finish this.
- Thus they got started on the first day of the first month at sanctifying, and on the eighth day of the month they came to the porch of Yehowah, so that they sanctified the house of Yehowah in eight days, and on the sixteenth day of the first month they finished. (2 Chronicles 29:17)
- All the congregation were bowing down while the trumpets were blaring, until the burnt offering was finished.
- And all the congregation were bowing down while the song was resounding and the trumpets were blaring, all this until the burnt offering was finished. (2 Chronicles 29:28)
- As soon as they finished offering it, the king and his servants bowed low and prostrated themselves.
- And as soon as they finished offering it up, the king and all those found with him bowed low and prostrated themselves. (2 Chronicles 29:29)
- When dedicating Solomon's temple, the offerings were so many that the Levites had to assist the priests, until the work was finished.

- Only the priests themselves happened to be too few, and they were not able to skin all the burnt offerings. So their brothers the Levites helped them out until the work was finished and until the priests could sanctify themselves, for the Levites were more upright of heart for sanctifying themselves than the priests. (2 Chronicles 29:34)
- As soon as the temple dedication was finished the people went through all of Judah and Ephraim breaking down all the high places.
- And as soon as they finished all this, all the Israelites that were found there went out to the cities of Judah, and they proceeded to break up the sacred pillars and cut down the sacred poles and pull down the high places and the altars out of all Judah and Benjamin and in Ephraim and Manasseh until they had finished, after which all the sons of Israel returned to their cities, each one to his own possession. (2 Chronicles 31:1)
- For four months the Israelites brought in the tenth parts laying them in heaps upon heaps, until the seventh month when they finished.
- In the third month they started the heaps by laying the lowest layer, and in the seventh month they finished. (2 Chronicles 31:7)
- The opposers to Ezra claimed that is the temple was finished, that the Jews would then pay neither tax nor tribute.
- Now let it become known to the king that, if this city should be rebuilt and its walls be finished, neither tax nor tribute nor toll will they give, and it will cause loss to the treasuries of the kings. (Ezra 4:13)
- We are making known to the king that, if that city should be rebuilt and its walls be finished, you also will certainly have no share beyond the River. (Ezra 4:16)
- And this is the word that they gave back to us, saying; We are the servants of the God of the heavens and the earth, and we are rebuilding the house that had been built many years before this, which a great king of Israel built and finished. (Ezra 5:11)
- And the older men of the Jews were building and making

progress under the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo, and they built and finished it due to the order of the God of Israel and due to the order of Cyrus and Darius and Artaxerxes the king of Persia. (Ezra 6:14)

- In Ezra's day the people had taken foreign wives and they started to separate themselves from them, and gradually they finished.
- And as soon as these things were finished, the princes approached me, saying; The people of Israel and the priests and the Levites have not separated themselves from the peoples of the lands as regards their detestable things, namely, the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Jebusites, the Ammonites, the Moabites, the Egyptians and the Amorites. (Ezra 9:1)
- And gradually they finished with all the men that had given a dwelling to foreign wives by the first day of the first month. (Ezra 10:17)
- The sun goes forth from one extremity of the heavens to the other, and no one is concealed from its heat.
- From one extremity of the heavens is its going forth, and its finished circuit is to their other extremities, and there is nothing concealed from its heat. (Psalms 19:6)
- The Psalmist bemoaned that he had finished his years like a whisper.
- For all our days have come to their decline in your fury, we have finished our years just like a whisper. (Psalms 90:9)
- The Psalmist prophesied that the sinners will all be finished off from the earth.
- The sinners will be finished off from the earth, and as for the wicked, they will be no longer. Bless Yehowah, O my soul. Praise Yah, you people! (Psalms 104:35)
- Moab is counseled to become a place of concealment for religious brother nations, like Israel. When Yehowah thus acts against all of these religious nations, it will bring to an end the oppression,

despoiling and trampling down of others, that false religion has brought. They will be completely finished off from the all the earth.

- May my dispersed ones reside as aliens even in you, O Moab.
 Become a place of concealment to them because of the despoiler.
 For the oppressor has reached his end, the despoiling has terminated, those trampling down others have been finished off the earth. (Isaiah 16:4)
- Through Isaiah Yehowah God warned those despoiling others that as soon as they finished despoiling, they would be despoiled.
- Woe to you who are despoiling, without you yourself being despoiled, and to you who are dealing treacherously, without others having dealt treacherously with you! As soon as you have finished as a despoiler, you will be despoiled. As soon as you have done with dealing treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you. (Isaiah 33:1)
- Jeremiah prophesied that Yehowah God would finish off any nation that would not serve under the yoke of Babylon.
- And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that will not serve him, even Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and the one that will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, until I shall have finished them off by his hand. (Jeremiah 27:8)
- Jeremiah spoke all of Yehowah God's words to the people until he had finished speaking.
- Now it came about that as soon as Jeremiah finished speaking to all the people all the words of Yehowah their God with which Yehowah their God had sent him to them, even all these words. (Jeremiah 43:1)
- The angel showing the Son of Man the measurements of the visionary temple, finished the measurements of the inner house.
- And he finished the measurements of the inner house, and he brought me out by the way of the gate the front of which was toward the east, and he measured it all around. (Ezekiel 42:15)

- Daniel interpreted the word mene to mean, God has measured the days of your kingdom and finished it.
- This is the interpretation of the word; Mene, God has numbered the days of your kingdom and has finished it. (Daniel 5:26)
- So Amos approached his God, realizing that the swarm of locusts would come forth from Yehowah God toward his people, because of their wickedness. The locust swarm would then eat up all of the vegetation of the land, so that Amos approached Yehowah God, and asked Yehowah to forgive his people, even Jacob, he pleading that Jacob was small in number, and so who would rise up in his behalf to save him.
- And it occurred that when it had finished eating up the vegetation of the land, I proceeded to say; O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, forgive, please. Who will rise up of Jacob? For he is small! (Amos 7:2)
- When Jesus finished all his sayings, the people were astounded at what he taught and spoke.
- Now when Jesus finished these sayings, the effect was that the crowds were astounded at his way of teaching. (Matthew 7:28)
- When Jesus finished giving instructions to his 12 apostles he sent them forth to preach.
- Now when Jesus had finished giving instructions to his twelve disciples, he set out from there to teach and preach in their cities. (Matthew 11:1)
- When Jesus finished giving many illustrations, then he left and went across country from there.
- Now when Jesus had finished these illustrations he went across country from there. (Matthew 13:53)
- Now when Jesus had finished these words, he departed from Galilee and came to the frontiers of Judea across the Jordan. (Matthew 19:1)
- Now when Jesus had finished all these sayings, he said to his

disciples. (Matthew 26:1)

- Jesus showed that he had a baptism to undergo, and he was distressed within himself until it was finished.
- Indeed, I have a baptism with which to be baptized, and how I am being distressed until it is finished! (Luke 12:50)
- Jesus send word to wicked Herod that he would not be finished with healings for three more days, thus showing he did not fear Herod, even though that man had killed John the Baptist.
- And he said to them; Go and tell that fox, Look! I am casting out demons and accomplishing healing today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be finished. (Luke 13:32)
- Jesus indicated that he had glorified his father upon the earth, having finished the work he had given him to do.
- I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the work you have given me to do. (John 17:4)
- Paul intended to finish his work among them before going to Jerusalem with their kind gift.
- Hence after I have finished with this and have got this fruit securely to them, I shall depart by way of you for Spain. (Romans 15:28)
- Yehowah God swore that many men would not enter into his rest, though his works were finished at the creation of mankind.
- For we who have exercised faith do enter into the rest, just as he has said; So I swore in my anger; They shall not enter into my rest, although his works were finished from the founding of the world. (Hebrews 4:3)
- When the two witnesses have finished their witnessing work, the wild beast will make war with them and kill them.
- And when they have finished their witnessing, the wild beast that ascends out of the abyss will make war with them and conquer them and kill them. (Revelation 11:7)

- The sanctuary in heaven became filled with smoke because of the glory of Yehowah God and through his power, until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.
- And the sanctuary became filled with smoke because of the glory of God and because of his power, and no one was able to enter into the sanctuary until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished. (Revelation 15:8)
