## ~FIRMLY (675)

[English, resolutely, decisively, definitely, determinedly, steadfastly, confidently, Opposite of, irresolutely]

- The repeating of the dream of Pharaoh twice meant that it was firmly established for Yehowah God to bring it about.
- And the fact that the dream was repeated to Pharaoh twice means that the thing is firmly established on the part of the true God, and the true God is speeding to do it. (Genesis 41:32)
- The sayers of mock verses would say, for Sihon to be firmly established.
- That is why the sayers of mock verses would say; Come to Heshbon. Let the city of Sihon be built and be proved firmly set up. (Numbers 21:27)
- Moses told Israel to be firmly resolved not to eat any sort of blood.
- Simply be firmly resolved not to eat the blood, because the blood is the soul and you must not eat the soul with the flesh.

  (Deuteronomy 12:23)
- Sampson asked the boy to guide his hand so that he could firmly feel the pillars of that house of false worship. Thereafter he brought the house down through his great God-given strength.
- Then Samson said to the boy that was holding him by his hand; Do permit me to feel the pillars upon which the house is firmly established and let me lean against them. (Judges 16:26)
- With that Samson braced himself against the two middle pillars upon which the house was firmly established, and got a grasp on them, one with his right and the other with his left hand. (Judges 16:29)
- Saul felt that as long as David lived, that his kingship was not firmly established.
- For all the days that the son of Jesse is alive on the ground, you

and your kingship will not be firmly established. So now send and fetch him to me, for he is destined for death. (1 Samuel 20:31)

- David came to know that Yehowah God had firmly established his kingship over Israel.
- And David came to know that Yehowah had firmly established him as king over Israel and that he had exalted his kingdom for the sake of his people Israel. (2 Samuel 5:12)
- Yehowah God promised David, that he himself would firmly establish his kingship in his family line after his death.
- When your days come to the full, and you must lie down with your forefathers, then I shall certainly raise up your seed after you, which will come out of your inward parts, and I shall indeed firmly establish his kingdom. (2 Samuel 7:12)
- He is the one that will build a house for my name, and I shall certainly establish the throne of his kingdom firmly to time indefinite. (2 Samuel 7:13)
- And your house and your kingdom will certainly be steadfast to time indefinite before you, your very throne will become one firmly established to time indefinite. (2 Samuel 7:16)
- And you proceeded to establish your people Israel firmly for yourself as your people to time indefinite, and you yourself, O Yehowah, have become their God. (2 Samuel 7:24)
- David asked for Yehowah God's name to be firmly established over Israel, and for his house to become firmly established.
- And let your own name become great to time indefinite, saying; Yehowah of armies is God over Israel, and let the very house of your servant David become firmly established before you. (2 Samuel 7:26)
- Gradually the kingship of Solomon became firmly established over all Israel.
- As for Solomon, he sat down upon the throne of David his father, and gradually his kingship became very firmly established. (1

## Kings 2:12)

- Solomon swore to put Adonijah to death, for his trying to unseat the throne of Solomon, which Yehowah God had firmly established.
- And now, as Yehowah is living who has firmly established me and keeps me seated upon the throne of David my father and who made a house for me just as he has spoken, today Adonijah will be put to death. (1 Kings 2:24)
- With that the king commanded Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, who then went out and fell upon him, so that he died. And the kingdom was firmly established in the hand of Solomon. (1 Kings 2:46)
- King Solomon was blessed and the throne of Yehowah God was firmly established in him.
- But King Solomon will be blessed, and the throne of David itself will prove to be firmly established before Yehowah forever. (1 Kings 2:45)
- David knew that Yehowah God had firmly established his kingship over Israel, for he was highly exalted on account of his people Israel.
- And David came to know that Yehowah had firmly established him as king over Israel, for his kingship was highly exalted on account of his people Israel. (1 Chronicles 14:2)
- The Levites sang a song in which they noted that the productive land was firmly established, and never would be made to totter.
- Be in severe pains on account of him, all you people of the earth!
  Also the productive land is firmly established. Never will it be made to totter. (1 Chronicles 16:30)
- Yehowah God promised David that one of his sons would always sit upon his throne, and he would firmly establish his kingship.
- And it must occur that when your days have come to the full for you to go to be with your forefathers, I shall certainly raise up your seed after you that will come to be one of your sons, and I shall indeed firmly establish his kingship. (1 Chronicles 17:11)

- David was told also that Solomon would be the one to build a house to Yehowah God, and God would firmly establish his kingship to time indefinite.
- He is the one that will build me a house, and I shall certainly establish his throne firmly to time indefinite. (1 Chronicles 17:12)
- It is he that will build a house to my name, and he himself will become a son to me, and I a father to him. And I shall certainly establish the throne of his kingship firmly over Israel to time indefinite. (1 Chronicles 22:10)
- And I shall certainly establish his kingship firmly to time indefinite if he will be strongly resolved to do my commandments and my judicial decisions, as at this day. (1 Chronicles 28:7)
- Rehoboam left the Law of Yehowah God, when his kingship became firmly established.
- And it came about that, as soon as the kingship of Rehoboam was firmly established and as soon as he was strong, he left the Law of Yehowah, and also all Israel with him. (2 Chronicles 12:1)
- Rehoboam had not firmly established his heart to search for Yehowah God.
- But he did what was bad, for he had not firmly established his heart to search for Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 12:14)
- Yehowah God kept the kingdom firmly established in Jehoshaphat's hand, and he came to have riches and glory in abundance.
- And Yehowah kept the kingdom firmly established in his hand, and all Judah continued to give presents to Jehoshaphat, and he came to have riches and glory in abundance. (2 Chronicles 17:5)
- When the Israelites returned to Jerusalem after the exile they first firmly established the altar on the old temple site.
- So they established the altar firmly upon its own site, for fright came upon them because of the peoples of the lands, and they began offering up burnt sacrifices to Yehowah upon it, the burnt

sacrifices of the morning and of the evening. (Ezra 3:3)

- Job showed that the wicked ones of the earth are the ones firmly established upon the earth, they and their offspring.
- Their offspring are firmly established with them in their sight, and their descendants before their eyes. (Job 21:8)
- The Psalmist showed, that Yehowah God will sit upon his throne to time indefinite, firmly establishing his throne to stand for judgment itself.
- As for Yehowah, he will sit to time indefinite, firmly establishing his throne for judgment itself. (Psalms 9:7)
- Yehowah God's Law is firmly established upon the seas and rivers of the earth.
- For upon the seas he himself has solidly fixed it, and upon the rivers he keeps it firmly established. (Psalms 24:2)
- The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God saved him and raised him up upon a crag, firmly establishing his steps.
- He also proceeded to bring me up out of a roaring pit, out of the mire of the sediment. Then he raised up my feet upon a crag, he firmly established my steps. (Psalms 40:2)
- Yehowah God will firmly establish his holy city to time indefinite.
- Just as we have heard, so we have seen in the city of Yehowah of armies, in the city of our God. God himself will firmly establish it to time indefinite. (Psalms 48:8)
- The Psalmist showed, that Yehowah God is firmly establishing the mountains in his power and mightiness.
- He is firmly establishing the mountains with his power, he is indeed girded with mightiness. (Psalms 65:6)
- Respecting Zion, it will be said that these ones were born in her, for the Most High will firmly establish her.
- And respecting Zion it will be said; Each and every one was born

in her. And the Most High himself will firmly establish her. (Psalms 87:5)

- Yehowah God keeps his loving-kindness and faithfulness firmly established in the heavens.
- For I have said; Loving-kindness will stay built even to time indefinite, as for the heavens, you keep your faithfulness firmly established in them. (Psalms 89:2)
- Yehowah God promised David's house to be firmly established to time indefinite, and his throne for generation after generation.
- Even to time indefinite I shall firmly establish your seed, and I will build your throne to generation after generation. (Psalms 89:4)
- Yehowah God promised David, that his seed would be as firmly established before him, as was the moon.
- As the moon it will be firmly established for time indefinite, and as a faithful witness in the skies. (Psalms 89:37)
- The Psalmist asked for Yehowah God to firmly establish the work of his hands upon his people.
- And let the pleasantness of Yehowah our God prove to be upon us, and the work of our hands do you firmly establish upon us. Yes, the work of our hands, do you firmly establish it. (Psalms 90:17)
- When Yehowah God becomes king, then the productive land will become firmly established, so that it cannot be made to totter.
- Yehowah himself has become king! With eminence he is clothed. Yehowah is clothed, with strength he has girded himself. The productive land also becomes firmly established so that it cannot be made to totter. (Psalms 93:1)
- Say among the nations; Yehowah himself has become king. The productive land also becomes firmly established so that it cannot be made to totter. He will plead the cause of the peoples in uprightness. (Psalms 96:10)

- The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God's throne was firmly established from long ago.
- Your throne is firmly established from long ago. You are from time indefinite. (Psalms 93:2)
- Yehowah God has firmly established uprightness, along with judgment and righteousness.
- And with the strength of a king, judgment he has loved. You yourself have firmly established uprightness. Judgment and righteousness in Jacob are what you yourself have effected. (Psalms 99:4)
- The Psalmist showed that anyone speaking falsehoods, would not be firmly established in front of his eyes.
- There will dwell inside my house no worker of trickiness. As for anyone speaking falsehoods, he will not be firmly established in front of my eyes. (Psalms 101:7)
- Before Yehowah God the sons of your servants will become firmly established.
- The sons of your servants will continue residing, and before you their own offspring will be firmly established. (Psalms 102:28)
- Yehowah God has firmly established his throne in the heavens, and over everything his kingship has held domination.
- Yehowah himself has firmly established his throne in the very heavens, and over everything his own kingship has held domination. (Psalms 103:19)
- The Psalmist showed how Yehowah God firmly establishes the hungry ones giving them a place to dwell.
- And there he causes the hungry ones to dwell, so that they firmly establish a city of habitation. (Psalms 107:36)
- The Psalmist wanted deeply to have the regulations of Yehowah God firmly established within himself.
- O that my ways were firmly established to keep your regulations!

## (Psalms 119:5)

- The Psalmist asks that the big talker not become firmly established in the earth.
- The big talker, let him not be firmly established in the earth. The man of violence, let evil itself hunt him with repeated thrusts. (Psalms 140:11)
- The path of righteous ones is like a bright light getting brighter and brighter as the day progresses and becomes firmly established.
- But the path of the righteous ones is like the bright light that is getting lighter and lighter until the day is firmly established. (Proverbs 4:18)
- The congregator wanted for his son to smooth out the ways of his foot, and make all of his ways firmly established.
- Smooth out the course of your foot, and may all your own ways be firmly established. (Proverbs 4:26)
- The one firmly standing for righteousness is in line for life.
- The one firmly standing for righteousness is in line for life, but the one chasing after what is bad is in line for his own death. (Proverbs 11:19)
- No one will be firmly established through the practice of wickedness.
- No man will be firmly established by wickedness, but as for the root-foundation of the righteous ones, it will not be caused to stagger. (Proverbs 12:3)
- It is the sayings of truth, that will be firmly established forever.
- It is the lip of truth that will be firmly established forever, but the tongue of falsehood will be only as long as a moment. (Proverbs 12:19)
- Roll your works upon Yehowah God himself, and your plans will be firmly established.

- Roll your works upon Yehowah himself and your plans will be firmly established. (Proverbs 16:3)
- By righteousness is a throne firmly established for a king.
- The doing of wickedness is something detestable to kings, for by righteousness is the throne firmly established. (Proverbs 16:12)
- Judgments have been firmly established for ridiculers, and strokes for the backs of stupid people.
- Judgments have been firmly established for ridiculers, and strokes for the back of stupid ones. (Proverbs 19:29)
- By means of shared counsel, plans themselves are firmly established.
- By counsel plans themselves are firmly established, and by skillful direction carry on your war. (Proverbs 20:18)
- The upright man is the one that will firmly establish his way.
- A wicked man has put on a bold face, but the upright is the one that will firmly establish his ways. (Proverbs 21:29)
- Men should incline their ears to hear the words of wise ones, that they may be firmly established upon their own lips.
- For it is pleasant that you should keep them in your belly, that they may be firmly established together upon your lips. (Proverbs 22:18)
- By wisdom and by discernment a household will prove to be firmly established.
- By wisdom a household will be built up, and by discernment it will prove firmly established. (Proverbs 24:3)
- Let there be a removing of the wicked one from before the king, so that his throne will become firmly established through righteousness itself.
- Let there be the removing of the wicked one before the king, and his throne will be firmly established by righteousness itself.

## **(Proverbs 25:5)**

- Where a king is judging the lowly ones in trueness, his throne will be firmly established forever.
- Where a king is judging the lowly ones in trueness, his throne will be firmly established for all time. (Proverbs 29:14)
- In the final part of the days the house of Yehowah God will become firmly established above the tops of the mountains, or powerful governments of the earth.
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it all the nations must stream. (Isaiah 2:2)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it peoples must stream. (Micah 4:1)
- The rule of the Messiah, the Greater David, will bring peace without end, and Yehowah God will firmly establish it, and sustain it, by means of justice and righteousness to time indefinite.
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies will do this. (Isaiah 9:7)
- In loving-kindness a throne is certainly firmly established.
- And in loving-kindness a throne will certainly be firmly established, and one must sit down upon it in trueness in the tent of David, judging and seeking justice and being prompt in righteousness. (Isaiah 16:5)
- Eliakim was given the robe and sash of Shebna, which was then firmly bound about him.
- And I will clothe him with your robe, and your sash I shall firmly bind about him, and your dominion I shall give into his hand, and

he must become a father to the inhabitant of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. (Isaiah 22:21)

- But this old system has neither a set course, or firm direction, it will therefore not meet its goals. When it falls, there will be spoil in abundance to be divided up, so that even lame ones will actually collect up a great amount of spoil.
- Your ropes must hang loose. Their mast they will not hold firmly erect. They have not spread a sail. At that time even spoil in abundance will have to be divided up. The lame ones themselves will actually take a big plunder. (Isaiah 33:23)
- Yehowah God as the creator of the earth did not create it for no purpose, but he **firmly** established it so as to be inhabited.
- For this is what Yehowah has said, the Creator of the heavens, He the true God, the Former of the earth and the Maker of it, He the One who firmly established it, who did not create it simply for nothing, who formed it even to be inhabited; I am Yehowah, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:18)
- Every single stone of this spiritual house will be hand selected by Yehowah God, our spiritual father and the overseer of our spiritual lives. He intimately knows each son, their thinking patterns and their spiritual qualities. He will place each one just as it suits him. Thus she will be firmly established in righteousness.
- You will prove to be firmly established in righteousness itself. You will be far away from oppression, for you will fear none, and from anything terrifying, for it will not come near you. (Isaiah 54:14)
- Yehowah God firmly established the productive land through his wisdom and power.
- He is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens. (Jeremiah 10:12)
- Then Yehowah will multiply his people like the sands of the seas as in the times of long ago. The way of the truth will then become firmly established. Also, all of the oppressive nations, that abused his

people down through time, he will give his attention to them, and bring them to ruin. True worship will be given a place on earth, a place of honor and respect for the thousand years.

- And his sons must become as in former times, and before me his own assembly will be firmly established. And I will turn my attention upon all his oppressors. (Jeremiah 30:20)
- Yehowah is the former of the earth firmly establishing it forever.
- This is what Yehowah the Maker of earth has said; Yehowah the Former of it to establish it firmly, Yehowah being his name. (Jeremiah 33:2)
- He is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens. (Jeremiah 51:15)
- Yehowah then began to bless this truth loving organization. He made it grow in leaps and bounds until it became great. He adorned it with the finest ornaments, beautifying it in the eyes of others. He then watched it develop into a mature wifely organization, with firm breasts, for feeding young ones, and a headdress, of exultant praise.
- A very big multitude like the sprouting of the field is what I made you so that you would grow big and become great and come in with the finest ornament. The two breasts themselves were firmly developed, and your own hair grew luxuriantly, when you had been naked and nude. (Ezekiel 16:7)
- Hosea then illustrates, what Yehowah will then become like to those returning to him in true repentance, those who want to truly know Yehowah, and who keep pursuing after the true knowledge of him. Yehowah is like the dawn, which firmly establishes the day itself. He will come in upon these tired and spiritually thirsting ones, like a spring rain, one that saturates the entire earth, bringing back to spiritual life those enjoying its bounteous measure.
- And we will know, we will pursue to know Yehowah. Like dawn, his going forth is firmly established. And he will come in like a pouring rain to us, like a spring rain that saturates the earth. (Hosea 6:3)

- Yehowah will then call to remembrance their majestic rulers and kings and princes. Those ones will stumble as they try to escape the destruction. They will hasten to the city's wall, yet outside of the wall another barricade will be firmly established, preventing their escape.
- He will remember his majestic ones. They will stumble in their walking. They will hasten to her wall, and the barricade will have to be firmly established. (Nahum 2:5)
- So the angel replied to Zechariah, that they were taking it to Shinar or Babylon, and there it must be firmly established, and she must be deposited there upon her proper place. For the cheating measure does not belong among God's clean people, for it is wickedness, and it must go, and firmly establish itself among the false religions of the earth, for it has no place among God's true worshipers.
- In turn he said to me; In order to build for her a house in the land of Shinar, and it must be firmly established, and she must be deposited there upon her proper place. (Zechariah 5:11)
- When Jesus days had come to the full for him to return to heaven to his father, he firmly set his face to go to Jerusalem.
- As the days were now coming to the full for him to be taken up, he firmly set his face to go to Jerusalem. (Luke 9:51)
- The overseer is to be firmly holding to the pattern of faithful words in his teaching methods and counsel.
- Holding firmly to the faithful word as respects his art of teaching, that he may be able both to exhort by the teaching that is healthful and to reprove those who contradict. (Titus 1:9)
- Peter reminded his spirit anointed Christian brothers of things they already knew, so that they would be firmly set in the truth, which was in them.
- For this reason I shall be disposed always to remind you of these things, although you know them and are firmly set in the truth that is present in you. (2 Peter 1:12)
