

~FITTING (100)

[English, appropriate, right, fit, proper, apostate, decent, correct,
Opposite of, inappropriate]

- On the part of upright ones among Yehowah God's people, praise is **fitting**.
- Cry out joyfully, O you righteous ones, because of Yehowah. On the part of the upright ones praise is **fitting**. (**Psalms 33:1**)
- Praise Yah, you people, for it is good to make melody to our God, for it is pleasant, praise is **fitting**. (**Psalms 147:1**)
- For the senseless one, the speaking about uprightness is not **fitting**.
- For anyone senseless the lip of uprightness is not **fitting**. How much less so for a noble the lip of falsehood! (**Proverbs 17:7**)
- Luxury is not **fitting** for stupid ones, nor should a servant rule over princes.
- Luxury is not **fitting** for anyone stupid. How much less for a servant to rule over princes! (**Proverbs 19:10**)
- Glory is not fitting for stupid ones, anymore than snow in summer, or heavy rains during the harvest.
- Like snow in summer and like rain in harvesttime, so glory is not **fitting** for a stupid one. (**Proverbs 26:1**)
- Men of the nations, who currently exercise their dominion over the earth, see themselves as wise ones, who will forever continue to guide mankind, but their wisdom is extremely fleeting when compared to God's. The error of their bad ways is quickly catching up with them, and they will surely be put to shame, when he exposes their error. The fear of Yehowah God is what is **fitting**.
- Who should not fear you, O King of the nations, for to you it is **fitting**, because among all the wise ones of the nations and among all their kingships there is in no way anyone like you. (**Jeremiah 10:7**)

- Paul shows that since men chose not to hold God in accurate knowledge, he also gave them up to a disapproved mental state to do the things not **fitting**.
- And just as they did not approve of holding God in accurate knowledge, God gave them up to a disapproved mental state, to do the things not **fitting**. (**Romans 1:28**)
- Paul told the Corinthians to judge for themselves whether it was **fitting** for a woman to pray with her head uncovered.
- Judge for your own selves. Is it **fitting** for a woman to pray uncovered to God? (**1 Corinthians 11:13**)
- Paul showed, that if it was **fitting** for him to accompany others to Jerusalem with their kind gift, then he would do so.
- However, if it is **fitting** for me to go there also, they will go there with me. (**1 Corinthians 16:4**)
- Paul felt obligated to thank God always for his spirit anointed Christian brothers, and it was **fitting**, because their faith and love kept growing exceedingly.
- We are obligated to give God thanks always for you, brothers, as it is **fitting**, because your faith is growing exceedingly and the love of each and all of you is increasing one toward the other. (**2 Thessalonians 1:3**)
- Paul counseled Titus to keep on speaking what things are **fitting** for healthful teaching.
- You, however, keep on speaking what things are **fitting** for healthful teaching. (**Titus 2:1**)
- It was fitting for Christ, in bringing many sons to glory, to himself be made perfect through sufferings.
- For it was **fitting** for the one for whose sake all things are and through whom all things are, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the Chief Agent of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (**Hebrews 2:10**)
