~FOLLOWERS (51)

[English, fans, admirers, hangers-on, devotees, disciples, adherents]

- Becoming a follower of Yehowah means to serve and obey his voice.
- If you will fear Yehowah and actually serve him and obey his voice, and you will not rebel against the order of Yehowah, both you and the king who must reign over you will certainly prove to be followers of Yehowah your God. (1 Samuel 12:14)
- Saul's son Ishbosheth ruled for two years over Israel and only the tribe of Judah followed David.
- Forty years old Ish-bosheth, Saul's son, was when he became king over Israel, and for two years he ruled as king. Only the house of Judah proved themselves followers of David. (2 Samuel 2:10)
- Joab and Zeruiah became followers of Adonijah and began offering him help.
- And he came to have dealings with Joab the son of Zeruiah and with Abiathar the priest, and they began offering help as followers of Adonijah. (1 Kings 1:7)
- It was then that the people of Israel began to divide themselves into two parts. There was one part of the people that became followers of Tibni the son of Ginath, to make him king, and the other part followers of Omri. (1 Kings 16:21)
- Party followers of Herod approached Jesus to pose difficult questions to him, so as to catch him in his speech, so as to get an accusation against him.
- So they dispatched to him their disciples, together with party followers of Herod, saying; Teacher, we know you are truthful and teach the way of God in truth, and you do not care for anybody, for you do not look upon men's outward appearance. (Matthew 22:16)
- At that the Pharisees went out and immediately began holding

council with the party followers of Herod against him, in order to destroy him. (Mark 3:6)

Next they sent forth to him some of the Pharisees and of the party followers of Herod, to catch him in his speech. (Mark 12:13)
