~FOLLOWER (63)

[English, fan, admirer, hanger-on, devotee, disciple, adherent]

- Saul promised to kill the cattle of anyone who would not become a follower of him and Samuel.
- So he took a pair of bulls and cut them in pieces and sent these into all the territory of Israel by the hand of the messengers, saying; Whoever of us is not going out as a follower of Saul and of Samuel, this is the way it will be done to his cattle! And the dread of Yehowah began to fall upon the people so that they came out as one man. (1 Samuel 11:7)
- The people of Israel made Jereboam king and none of them became a follower of David's house.
- And it came about that as soon as all Israel heard that Jeroboam had returned, they at once sent and called him to the assembly and made him king over all Israel. None became a follower of the house of David except the tribe of Judah by itself. (1 Kings 12:20)
- Jesus caught sight of Matthew, and asked him to be his follower.
- Next, while passing along from there, Jesus caught sight of a man named Matthew seated at the tax office, and he said to him, Be my follower. Thereupon he did rise up and follow him. (Matthew 9:9)
- But as he was passing along, he caught sight of Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. And rising up he followed him. (Mark 2:14)
- Now after these things he went out and beheld a tax collector named Levi sitting at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. (Luke 5:27)
- Jesus encouraged a rich young ruler to give his wealth to the poor and to come and be his follower.
- Jesus said to him; If you want to be perfect, go sell your belongings and give to the poor and you will have treasure in

heaven, and come be my follower. (Matthew 19:21)

- Jesus looked upon him and felt love for him and said to him; One thing is missing about you. Go, sell what things you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven, and come be my follower. (Mark 10:21)
- Then he said to another; Be my follower. The man said; Permit me first to leave and bury my father. (Luke 9:59)
- After hearing that, Jesus said to him; There is yet one thing lacking about you. Sell all the things you have and distribute to poor people, and you will have treasure in the heavens, and come be my follower. (Luke 18:22)
- The next day he desired to depart for Galilee. So Jesus found Philip and said to him; Be my follower. (John 1:43)
