

## ~FORBIDDEN (29)

[English, prohibited, not allowed, banned, outlawed, illegal, illicit,  
Opposite of, permissible]

- An unmarried woman under her father's guidance who took a vow could have it cancelled by her father as soon as he heard of it, if he so desired.
- But if her father has **forbidden** her on the day of his hearing all her vows or her abstinence vows that she has bound upon her soul, it will not stand, but Yehowah will forgive her, because her father forbade her. (**Numbers 30:5**)
- A husband of a married woman could exercise similar supervision.
- And her husband has heard it and has kept silent toward her, he has not **forbidden** her, and all her vows must stand or any abstinence vow that she has bound upon her soul will stand. (**Numbers 30:11**)
- At a certain time in Paul's ministry he was **forbidden** by the Holy Spirit from preaching in the district of Asia.
- Moreover, they went through Phrygia and the country of Galatia, because they were **forbidden** by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in the district of Asia. (**Acts of Apostles 16:6**)
