

## ~FORBIDDING (27)

[English, sinister, threatening, frightening, inhospitable, unwelcoming, unfriendly, hostile, dark, grim, Opposite of, **hospitable**]

- Christ was falsely accused of **forbidding** the paying of taxes.
- Then they started to accuse him, saying; This man we found subverting our nation and **forbidding** the paying of taxes to Caesar and saying he himself is Christ a king. (**Luke 23:2**)
- Paul spoke of false Christians who would arise in later times who would forbid marriage to their members. This had a fulfillment in the Catholic Church and its celibate Priests and Nuns. Paul showed that it is a teaching of the demons.
- However, the inspired utterance says definitely that in later periods of time some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to misleading inspired utterances and **teachings of demons**. (**1 Timothy 4:1**)
- **Forbidding to marry**, commanding to **abstain from foods** which God created to be partaken of with thanksgiving by those who have faith and accurately know the truth. (**1 Timothy 4:3**)
